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APRIL 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 106 million pounds (48.1 thousand metric tons) in April 1984, 14 percent below April 1983 and 4 percent below March 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 250 million pounds (114 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below April 1983 and 1 percent above March 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during April 1984 was 415 million pounds (188 thousand metric tons), up 1 percent from both April 1983 and March 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 62.3 million pounds (28.3 thousand metric tons), up 1 percent April 1983 but 2 percent below March 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 20.1 million pounds (9110 metric tons), 6 percent above April 1983 and 1 percent above March 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production, at 57.3 million pounds (26.0 thousand metric tons), was down 5 percent from April 1983 but up 12 percent March 1984.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with April 1983)

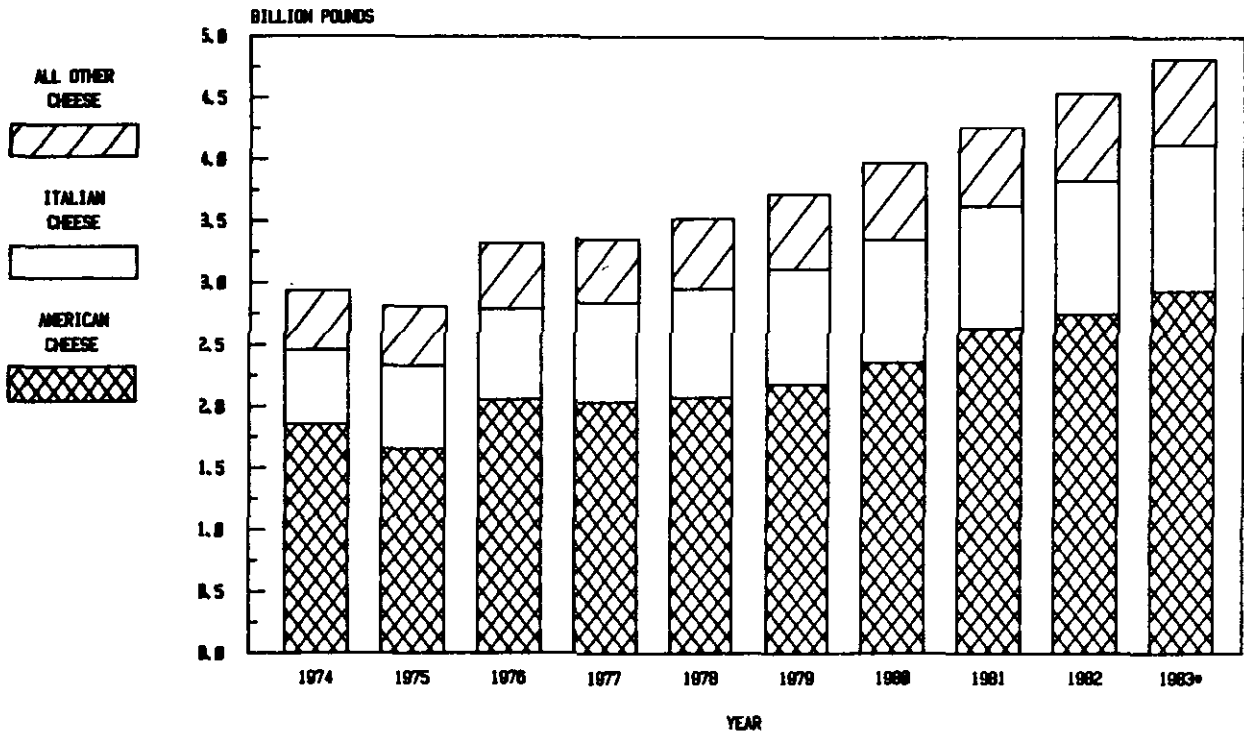
Ice cream -- 72.8 million gallons (276 million liters), up 4 percent.
Ice milk -- 25.5 million gallons (96.6 million liters), up 5 percent.
Sherbet -- 4.01 million gallons (15.2 million liters), up 9 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with April 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 114 million pounds (51.6 thousand metric tons), down 18 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 10.6 million pounds (4800 metric tons), up 15 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 3.51 million pounds (1590 metric tons), down 26 percent.
