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# Dairy Products



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## MAY 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 106 million pounds (48.0 thousand metric tons) in May 1984, 12 percent below May 1983 and unchanged from April 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 270 million pounds (122 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below May 1983 but 8 percent above April 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during May 1984 was 437 million pounds (198 thousand metric tons), down 1 percent from May 1983 but 5 percent above April 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 65.6 million pounds (29.7 thousand metric tons), unchanged from May 1983 but 5 percent above April 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 20.5 million pounds (9320 metric tons), up 2 percent from both May 1983 and April 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production, at 60.8 million pounds (27.6 thousand metric tons), was down 3 percent from May 1983 but up 6 percent April 1984.

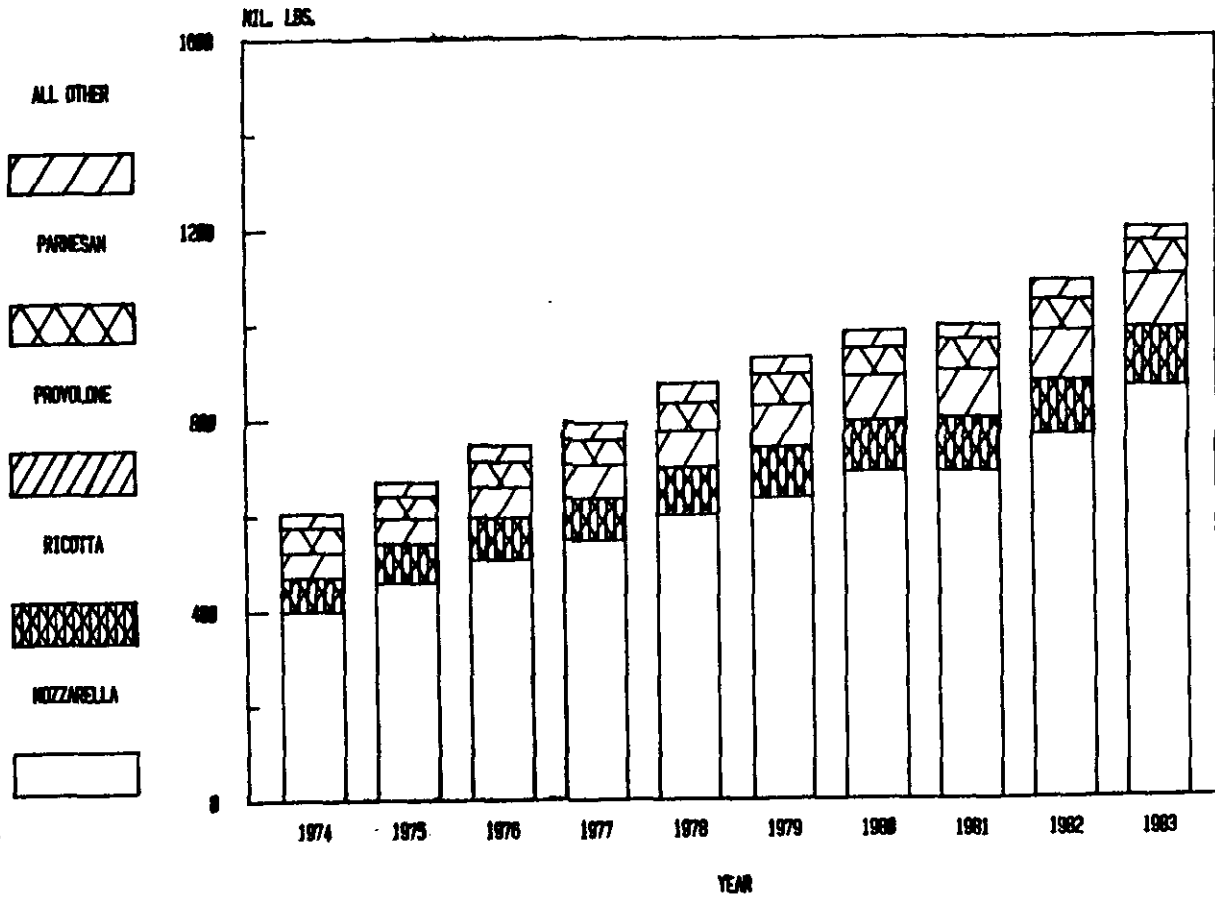
Ice cream -- 81.8 million gallons (310 million liters), up 4 percent.  
Ice milk -- 31.4 million gallons (119 million liters), up 7 percent.  
Sherbet -- 4.36 million gallons (16.5 million liters), down 1 percent.

### Dry milk products: (Comparisons with May 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 128 million pounds (58.3 thousand metric tons), down 16 percent.  
Dry whole milk -- 9.99 million pounds (4530 metric tons), up 7 percent.  
Dry buttermilk -- 4.14 million pounds (1880 metric tons), down 3 percent.
