## JUNE 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 80.3 million pounds (36.4 thousand metric tons) in June 1984, 23 percent below June 1983, and 24 percent below May 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 257 million pounds (117 thousand metric tons), 10 percent below June 1983 and 5 percent below May 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during June was 420 million pounds (190 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below June 1983 and 4 percent below May 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 64.6 million pounds (29.3 thousand metric tons), the same as June last year but 1 percent below May 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 20.8 million pounds (9420 metric tons), 7 percent above June 1983 and 1 percent above May 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production, at 55.4 million pounds (25.1 thousand metric tons), was down 16 percent from June 1983 and 9 percent from May 1984.

### Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with June 1983)

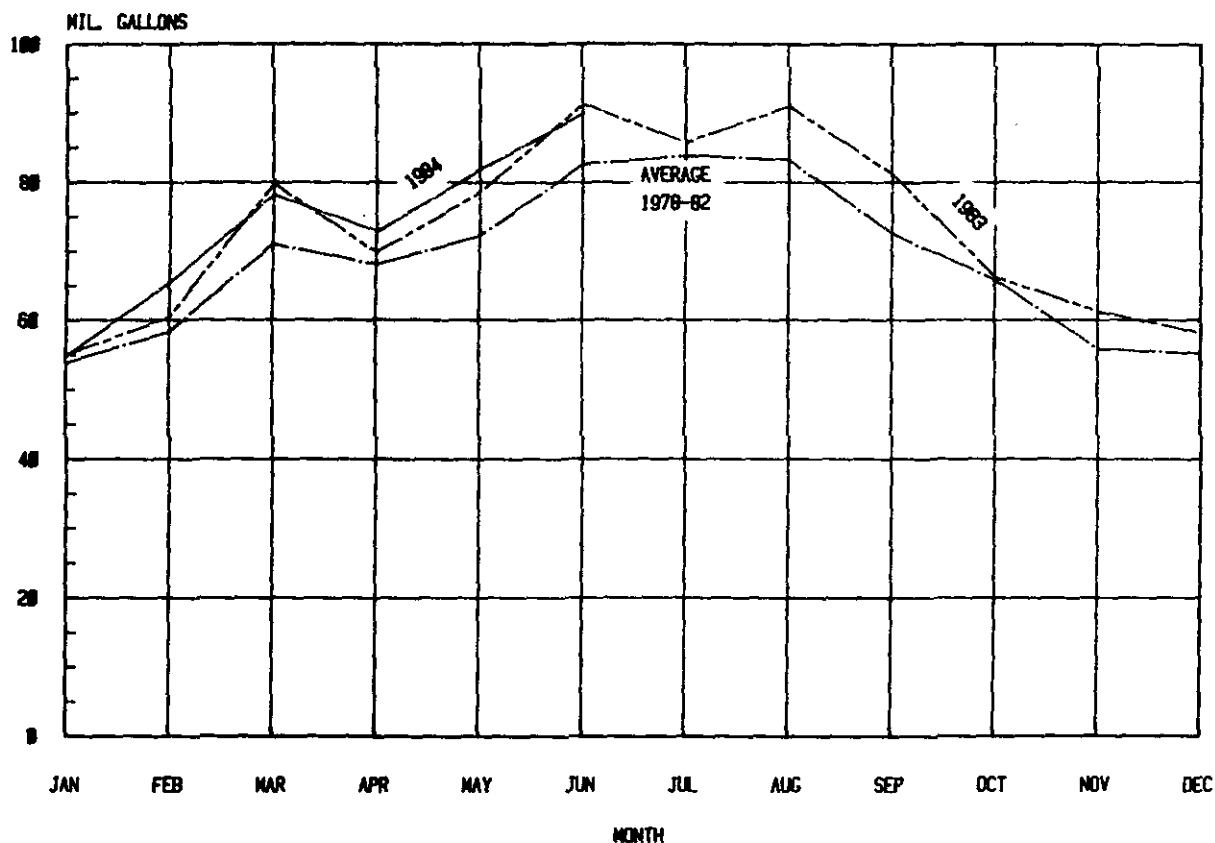
Ice cream -- 89.9 million gallons (340 million liters), down 2 percent.  
Ice milk -- 34.0 million gallons (129 million liters), up 3 percent.  
Sherbet -- 5.30 million gallons (20.1 million liters), up 2 percent.

### Dry milk products: (Comparisons with June 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 120 million pounds (54.3 thousand metric tons), down 22 percent.  
Dry whole milk -- 12.1 million pounds (5470 metric tons), up 37 percent.  
Dry buttermilk -- 3.19 million pounds (1450 metric tons), down 17 percent.
