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JULY 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 72.8 million pounds (33.0 thousand metric tons), 20 percent below July 1983, and 9 percent below June 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 230 million pounds (104 thousand metric tons), 12 percent below July 1983 and 11 percent below June 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during July was 388 million pounds (176 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below July 1983 and 8 percent below June 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 63.8 million pounds (29.0 thousand metric tons), the same as July 1983 but 1 percent less than June 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 19.4 million pounds (8810 metric tons), 8 percent above July 1983 but 6 percent below June 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production, at 54.1 million pounds (24.6 thousand metric tons), was down 7 percent from July 1983 and was 2 percent below June 1984.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with July 1983)

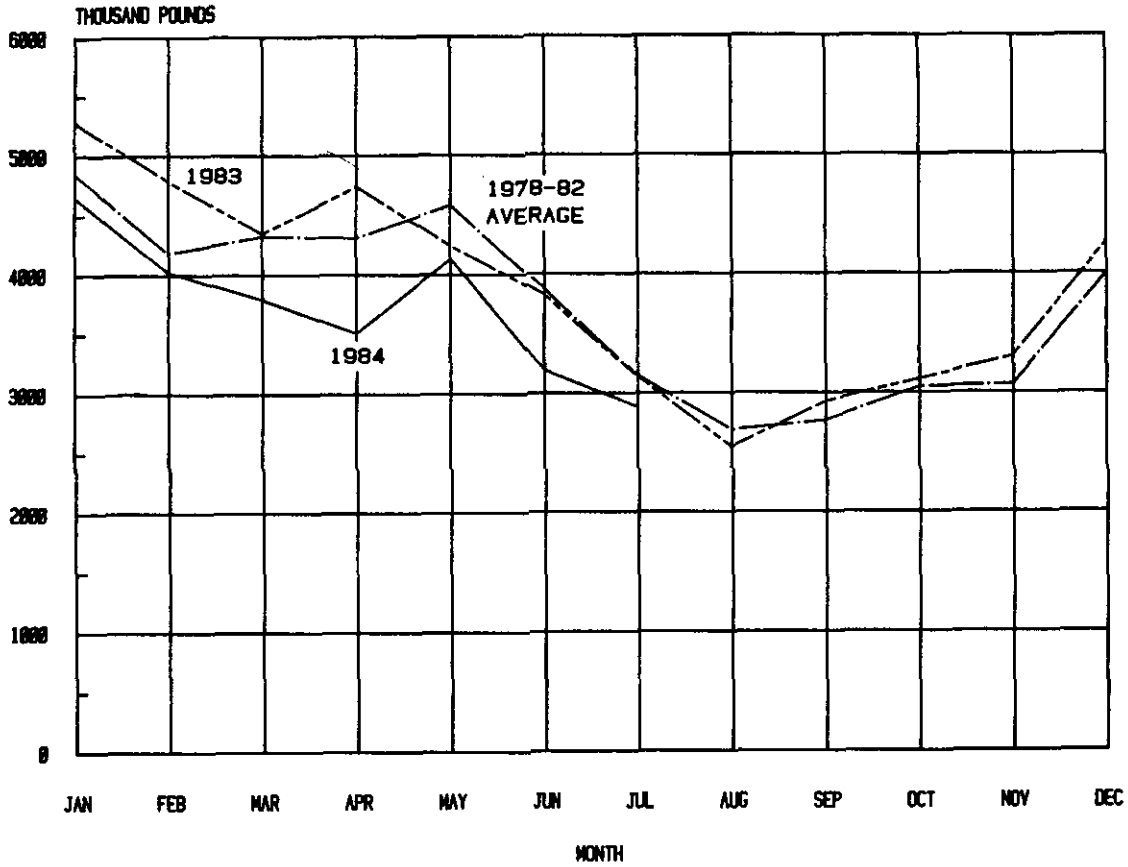
Ice cream -- 87.9 million gallons (333 million liters), up 3 percent.
Ice milk -- 34.0 million gallons (129 million liters), up 4 percent.
Sherbet -- 5.06 million gallons (19.1 million liters), down 5 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with July 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 112 million pounds (50.6 thousand metric tons), down 22 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 9.76 million pounds (4420 metric tons), up 25 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 2.88 million pounds (1310 metric tons), down 8 percent.

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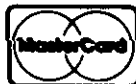
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
