SEPTEMBER 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 69.1 million pounds (31.4 thousand metric tons), 18 percent below September 1983 and 2 percent below August 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 185 million pounds (84.0 thousand metric tons), 12 percent below September last year and 10 percent below August 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during September was 349 million pounds (158 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below September 1983 and 5 percent below August 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 58.9 million pounds (26.7 thousand metric tons), 10 percent below both last year and last month.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 18.7 million pounds (8480 metric tons), 3 percent above September 1983 but 10 percent below August 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production, at 50.5 million pounds (22.9 thousand metric tons), was 3 percent below September 1983 and 6 percent below August 1984.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with September 1983)

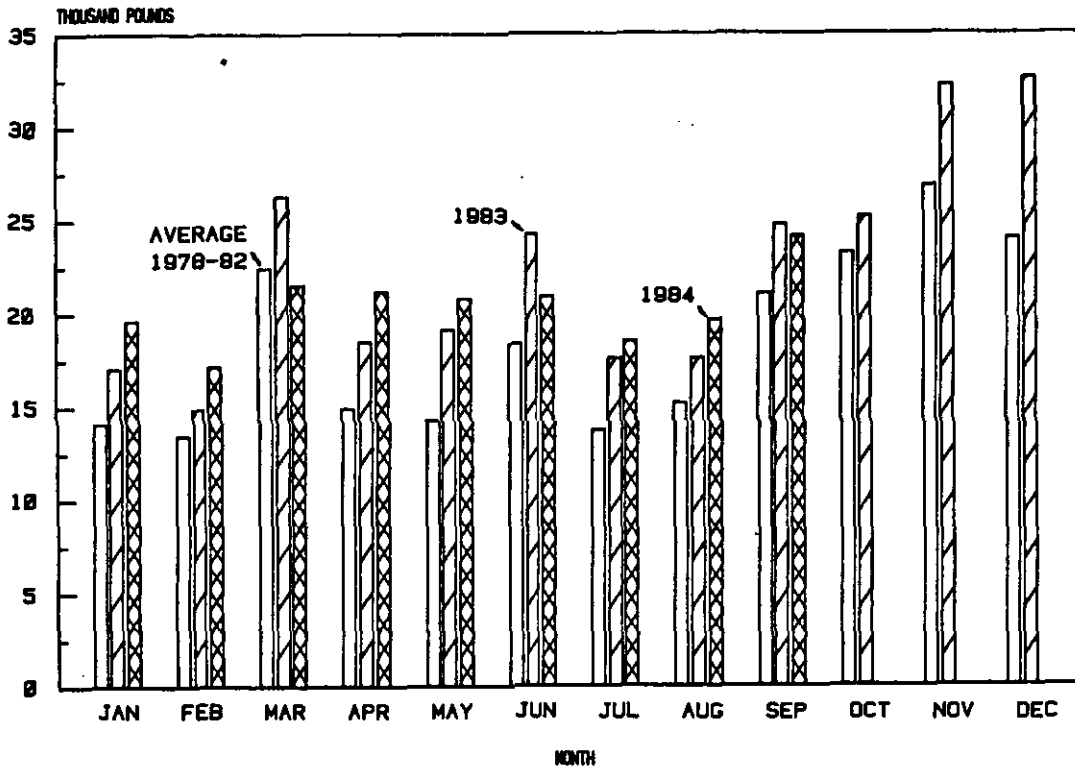
Ice cream -- 74.3 million gallons (281 million liters), down 9 percent.
Ice milk -- 25.5 million gallons (96.4 million liters), down 7 percent.
Sherbet -- 3.66 million gallons (13.9 million liters), down 9 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with September 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 71.1 million pounds (32.5 thousand metric tons), down 30 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 10.2 million pounds (4640 metric tons), up 9 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 2.28 million pounds (1040 metric tons), down 22 percent.
