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## OCTOBER 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 86.3 million pounds (39.1 thousand metric tons), 14 percent below October 1983 but 25 percent above September 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 197 million pounds (89.2 thousand metric tons), 12 percent below October 1983 but 6 percent above last month.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during October was 378 million pounds (171 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below October last year but 8 above September 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 60.7 million pounds (27.5 thousand metric tons), the same as October 1983 but 3 percent above September 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 20.8 million pounds (9430 metric tons), 23 percent above October 1983 and 11 percent above September 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 53.0 million pounds (24.0 thousand metric tons), the same as October 1983 but 5 percent above September 1984.

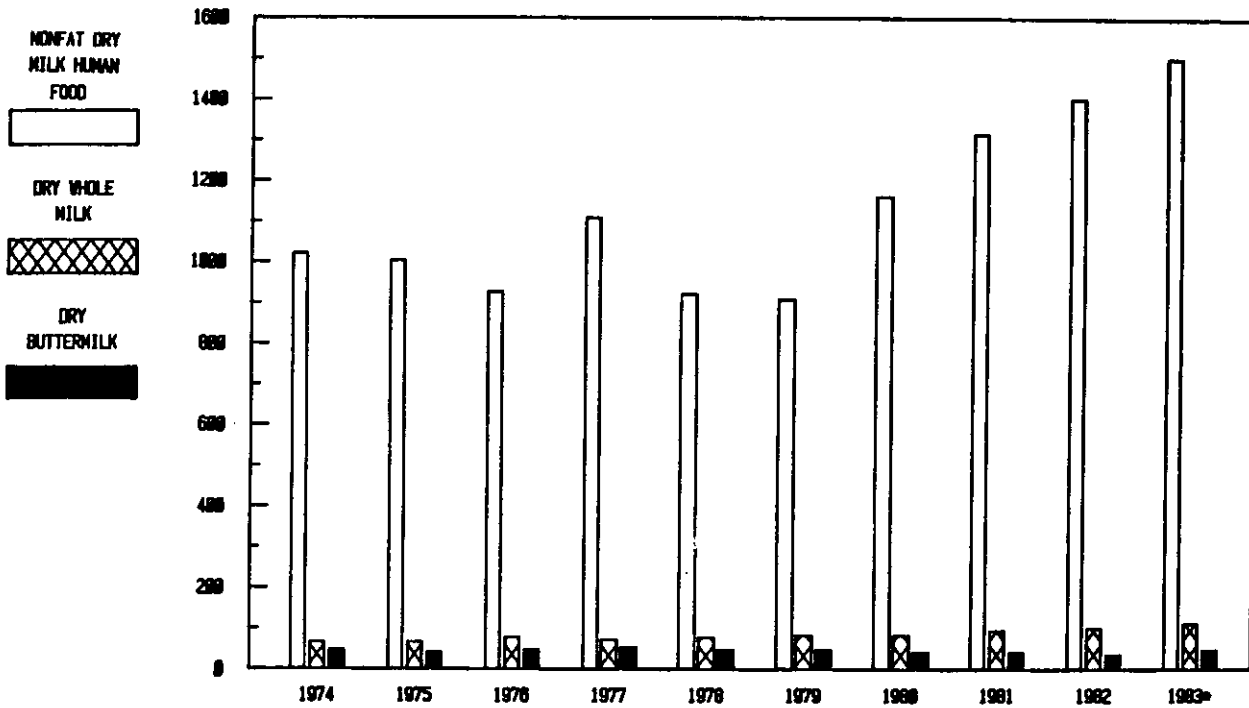
Ice cream -- 67.6 million gallons (256 million liters), up 2 percent.  
Ice milk -- 24.1 million gallons (91.3 million liters), up 12 percent.  
Sherbet -- 3.27 million gallons (12.4 million liters), up 14 percent.

### Dry milk products: (Comparisons with October 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 72.2 million pounds (32.7 thousand metric tons), down 30 percent.  
Dry whole milk -- 9.35 million pounds (4240 metric tons), down 8 percent.  
Dry buttermilk -- 2.62 million pounds (1190 metric tons), down 16 percent.
