NOVEMBER 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 81.1 million pounds (36.8 thousand metric tons), 17 percent below November 1983 and 6 percent below October 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 191 million pounds (86.6 thousand metric tons), 12 percent below November 1983 and 3 percent below October 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during November was 372 million pounds (169 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below November 1983 and 2 percent below October 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 55.8 million pounds (25.3 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below November 1983 and 8 percent below October 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 17.5 million pounds (7950 metric tons), 10 percent above November 1983 but 16 percent below October 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 48.3 million pounds (21.9 thousand metric tons), 20 percent below the November 1983 production and 9 percent below October 1984.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with November 1983)

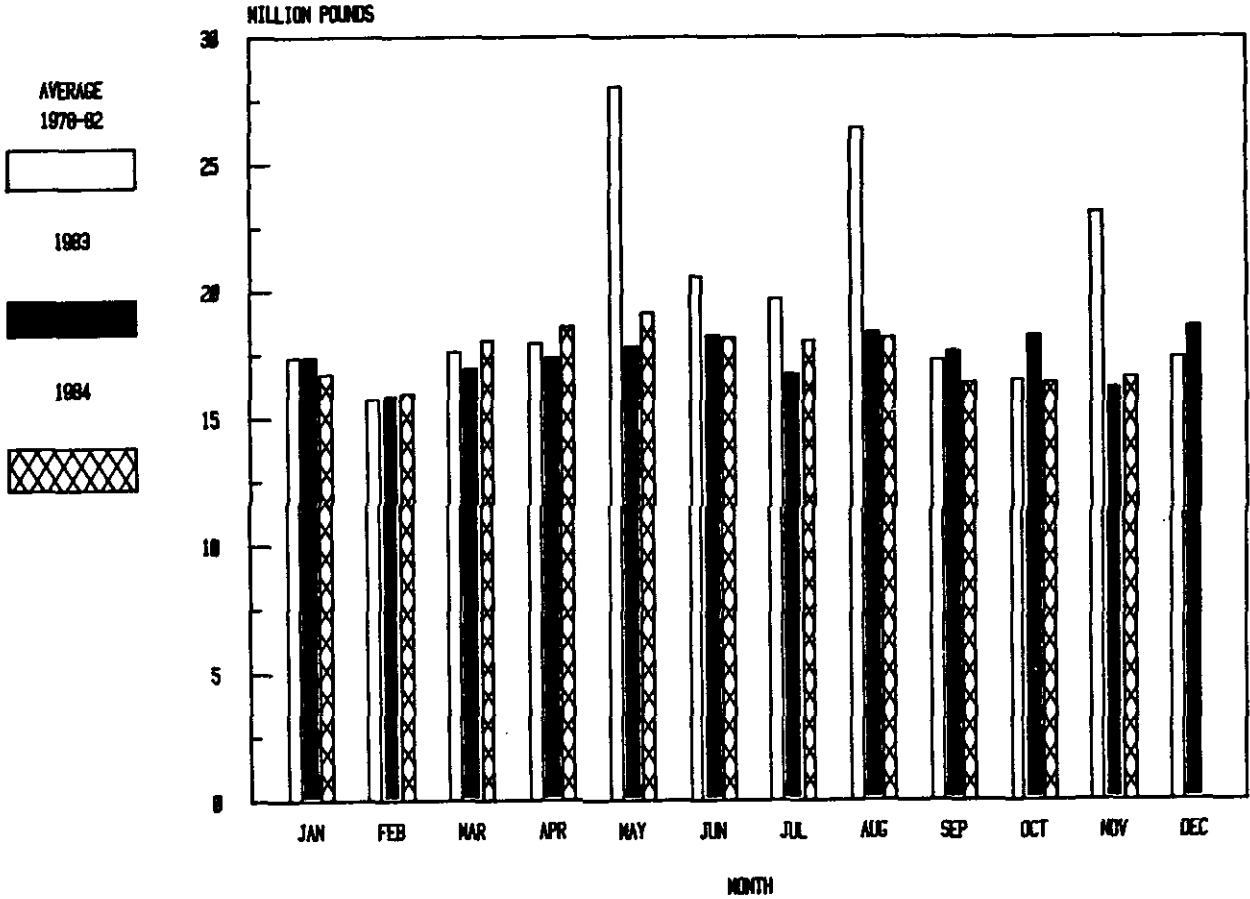
Ice cream -- 61.3 million gallons (232 million liters), unchanged.
Ice milk -- 19.5 million gallons (73.7 million liters), up 8 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.86 million gallons (10.8 million liters), up 5 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with November 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 69.7 million pounds (31.6 thousand metric tons), down 30 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 9.77 million pounds (4430 metric tons), down 7 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 2.58 million pounds (1170 metric tons), down 22 percent.
