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DECEMBER 1984 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 97.3 million pounds (44.1 thousand metric tons), 11 percent below December 1983 but 20 percent above November 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 210 million pounds (95.3 thousand metric tons), 11 percent below December 1983 but 10 percent above November 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during December was 392 million pounds (178 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below December 1983 but 6 percent above November 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 50.7 million pounds (23.0 thousand metric tons), 5 percent less than December 1983 and 9 percent less than November 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 15.6 million pounds (7080 metric tons), 11 percent above December 1983 but 11 percent below November 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 53.5 million pounds (24.3 thousand metric tons), 15 percent below December 1983 but 11 percent above November 1984.

Frozen Desserts: (Comparisons with December 1983)

Ice cream -- 54.4 million gallons (206 million liters), down 6 percent.
Ice milk -- 17.9 million gallons (67.6 million liters), up 10 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.70 million gallons (10.2 million liters), up 2 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with December 1983)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 85.2 million pounds (38.7 thousand metric tons), down 23 percent.

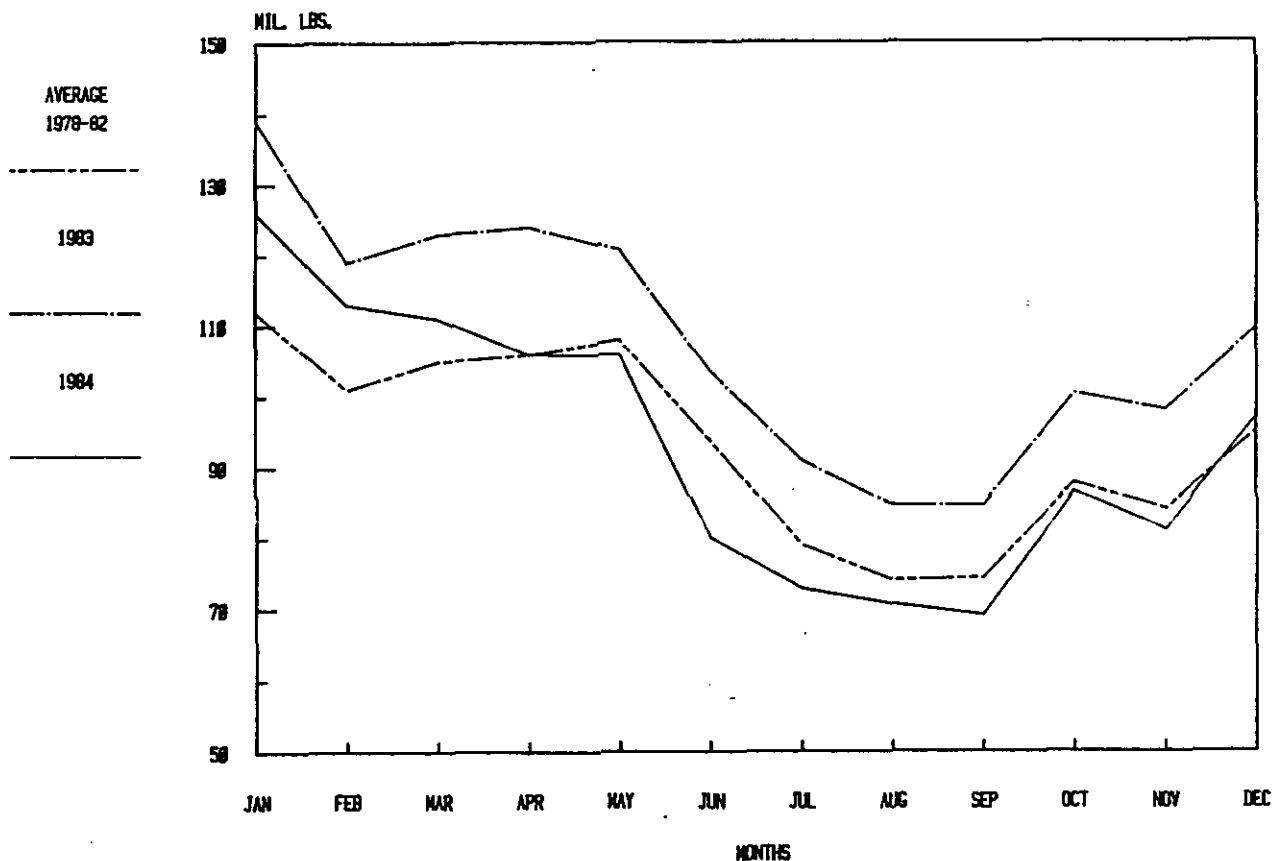
Dry whole milk -- 9.93 million pounds (4505 metric tons), up 1 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.64 million pounds (1650 metric tons), down 14 percent.

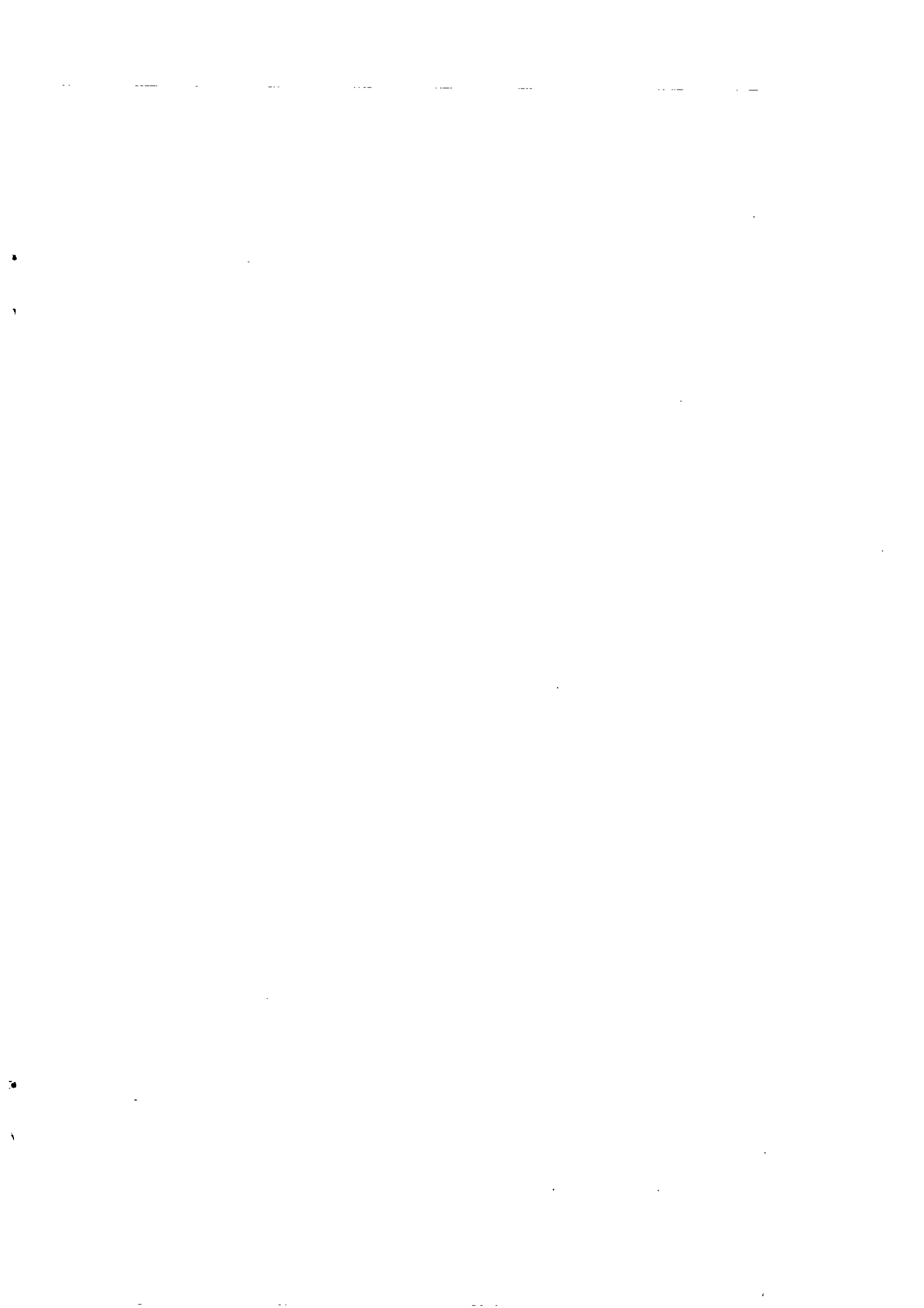
