JANUARY 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 118 million pounds (53.7 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below January 1984 but 22 percent above December 1984.

American type cheese production totaled 223 million pounds (101 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below January 1984 but 6 percent above December 1984.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during January was 391 million pounds (177 thousand metric tons), 1 percent above January 1984, and about the same as December 1984.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 60.0 million pounds (27.2 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above January 1984 and 18 percent above December 1984.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 18.8 million pounds (8530 metric tons), 9 percent above January 1984 and 21 percent above December 1984.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 44.2 million pounds (20.1 thousand metric tons), 9 percent below January 1984 and 17 percent below December 1984.

Frozen Desserts: (Comparisons with January 1984)

Ice cream -- 59.0 million gallons (223 million liters), up 8 percent.
Ice milk -- 17.6 million gallons (66.8 million liters), up 3 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.92 million gallons (11.0 million liters), up 5 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with January 1984)

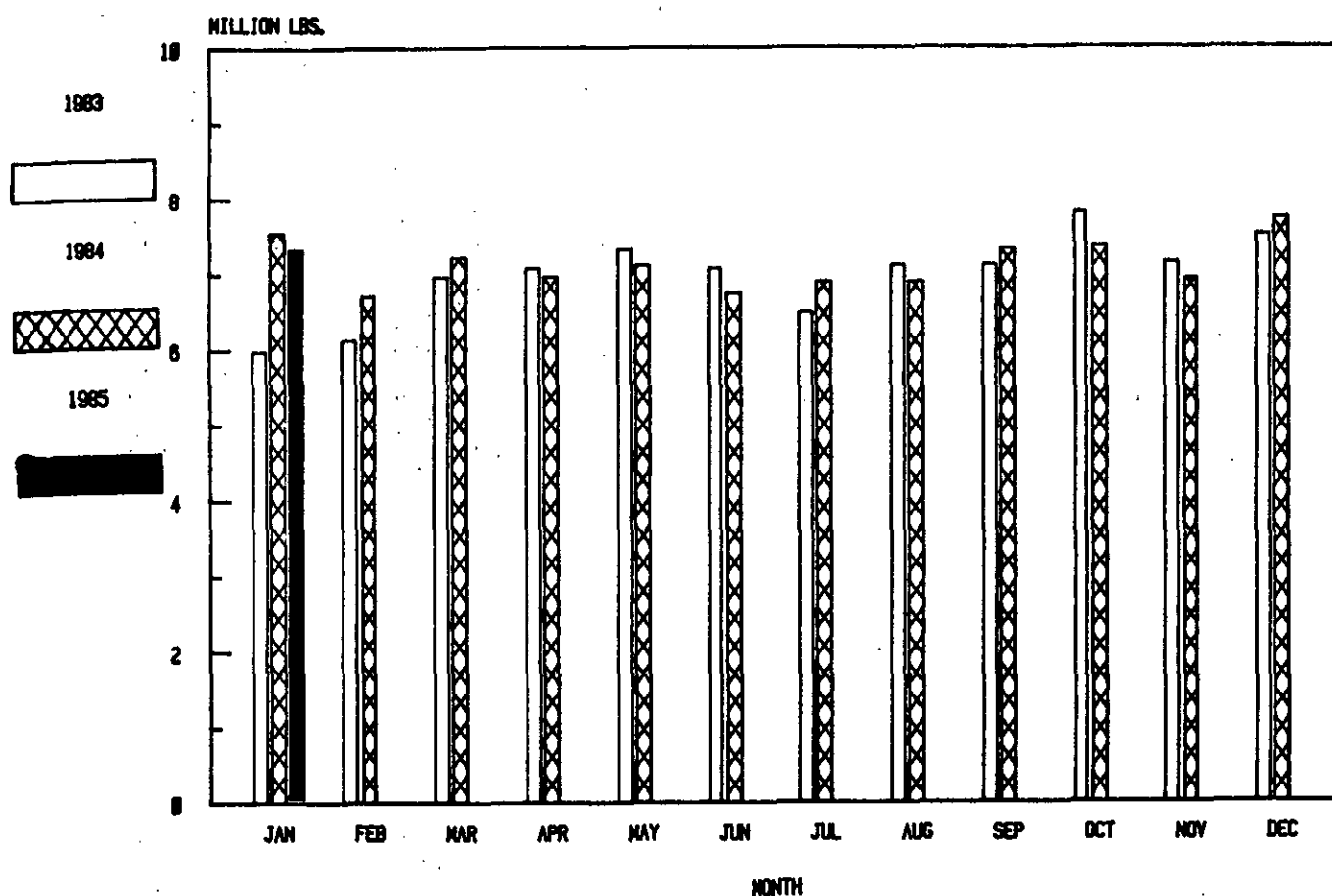
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 88.4 million pounds (40.1 thousand metric tons), down 21 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 11.7 million pounds (5320 metric tons), up 13 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.61 million pounds (2090 metric tons), down 1 percent.
