## FEBRUARY 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 108 million pounds (48.8 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below February 1984 (February 1984 contained 29 days) and 9 percent below January 1985.

American type cheese production totaled 202 million pounds (91.5 thousand metric tons), 9 percent below February 1984 and 10 percent below January 1985.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during February was 355 million pounds (161 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below February 1984 and 9 percent below January 1985.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 56.0 million pounds (25.4 thousand metric tons), 7 percent below February 1984 and January 1985.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 18.7 million pounds (8490 metric tons), 3 percent above February 1984 but 1 percent below January 1985.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 43.1 million pounds (19.6 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below February 1984 and January 1985.

### Frozen Desserts: (Comparisons with February 1984)

Ice cream -- 59.2 million gallons (224 million liters), down 10 percent.  
Ice milk -- 18.7 million gallons (70.8 million liters), down 11 percent.  
Sherbet -- 2.82 million gallons (10.7 million liters), down 6 percent.

### Dry milk products: (Comparisons with February 1984)

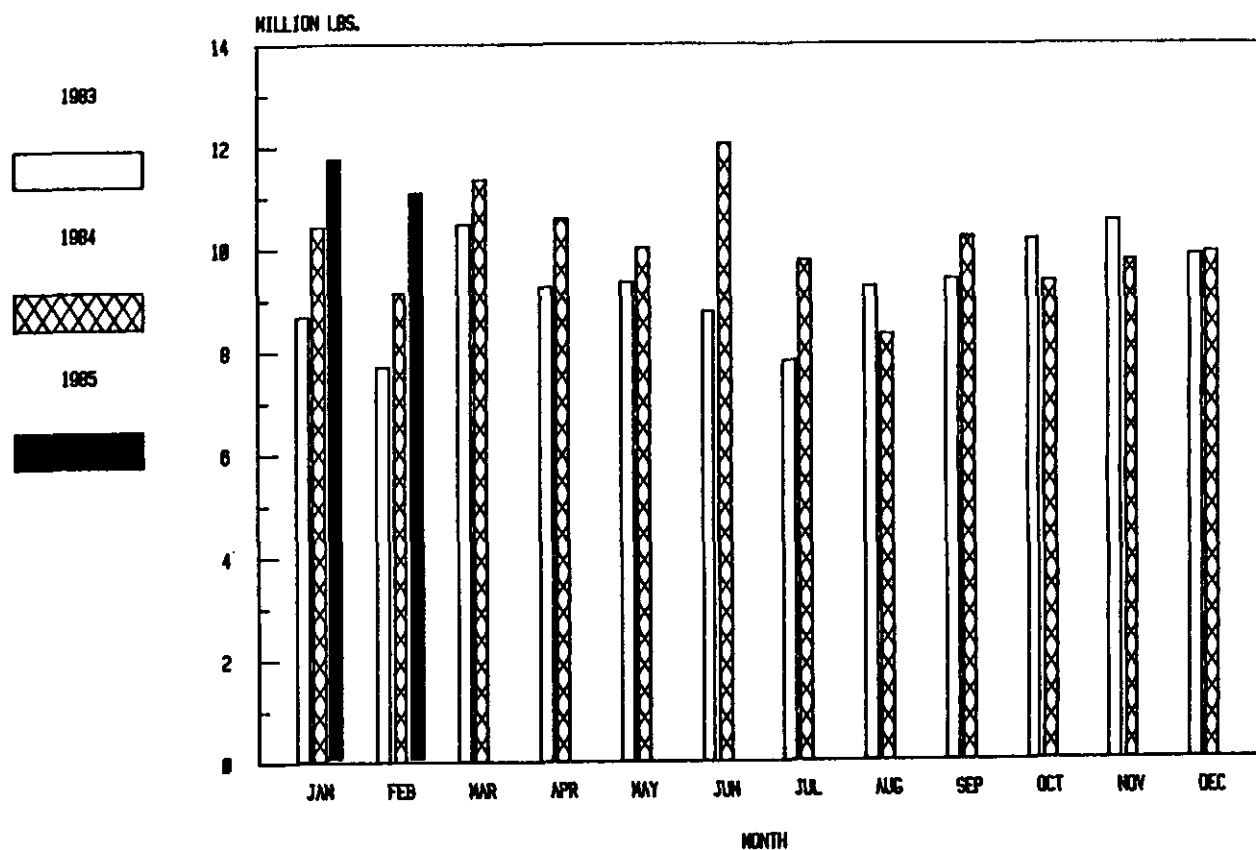
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 91.1 million pounds (41.3 thousand metric tons), down 13 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 11.1 million pounds (5030 metric tons), up 21 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.26 million pounds (1930 metric tons), up 6 percent.
