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APRIL 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 111 million pounds (50.3 thousand metric tons), 8 percent above April 1984 and 3 percent above March 1985.

American type cheese production totaled 251 million pounds (114 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above April 1984 and 9 percent above March 1985.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during April was 424 million pounds (192 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above April 1984 and March 1985.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 63.1 million pounds (28.6 thousand metric tons), 1 percent above April 1984 and 2 percent above March 1985.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 21.2 million pounds (9600 metric tons), 5 percent above April 1984 and virtually unchanged from March 1985.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 59.3 million pounds (26.9 thousand metric tons), 5 percent above April 1984 and 17 percent above March 1985.

Frozen Desserts: (Comparisons with April 1984)

Ice cream -- 74.4 million gallons (282 million liters), up 1 percent.

Ice milk -- 28.4 million gallons (107 million liters), up 13 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.24 million gallons (16.1 million liters), up 8 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with April 1984)

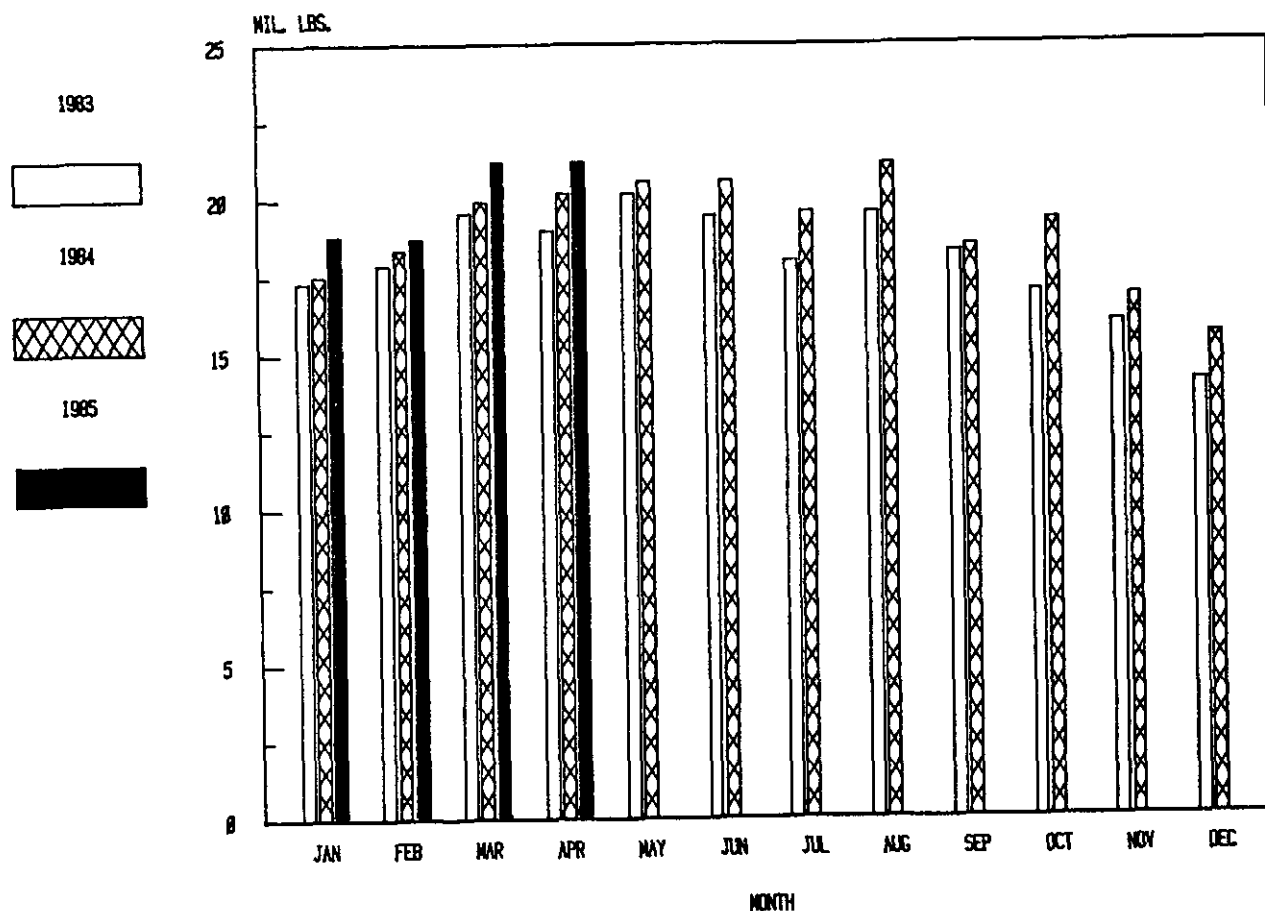
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 126 million pounds (57.1 thousand metric tons), up 11 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 10.9 million pounds (4930 metric tons), up 4 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.89 million pounds (1770 metric tons), up 15 percent.
