JUNE 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

Butter production was 97.3 million pounds (44.1 thousand metric tons), 19 percent above June 1984 but 14 percent below May 1985.

American type cheese production totaled 265 million pounds (120 thousand metric tons), 6 percent above June 1984 but 2 percent below May 1985.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) during June was 441 million pounds (200 thousand metric tons), 6 percent above June 1984 but 2 percent below May 1985.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 59.8 million pounds (27.1 thousand metric tons), 7 percent below June 1984 and 11 percent below May 1985.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 21.2 million pounds (9600 metric tons), 3 percent above June 1984 but 8 percent below May 1985.

Canned evaporated and condensed whole milk production was 57.8 million pounds (26.2 thousand metric tons), 6 percent above June 1984 but 6 percent below May 1985.

Frozen desserts: (Comparisons with June 1984)

Ice cream -- 87.5 million gallons (331 million liters), down 3 percent.

Ice milk -- 32.8 million gallons (124 million liters), down 2 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.89 million gallons (18.5 million liters), down 9 percent.

Dry milk products: (Comparisons with June 1984)

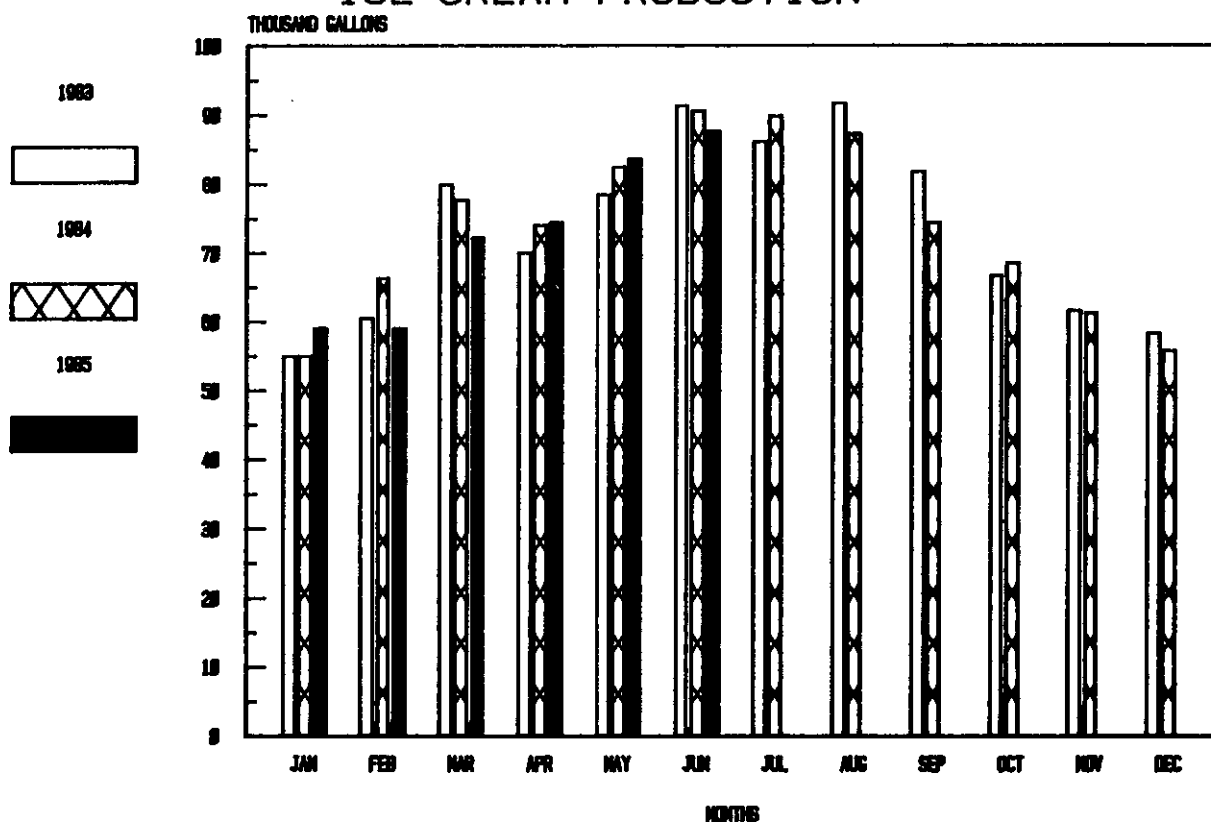
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 143 million pounds (65.0 thousand metric tons), up 23 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 11.0 million pounds (4970 metric tons), down 8 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.62 million pounds (1640 metric tons), up 16 percent.
