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## JULY 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 94.7 million pounds (43.0 thousand metric tons), 30 percent above July 1984 but 3 percent below June 1985.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 251 million pounds (114 thousand metric tons), 15 percent more than July 1984 but 5 percent less than June 1985.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) amounted to 429 million pounds (195 thousand metric tons), 13 percent more than July 1984 but 3 percent less than June 1985.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 64.3 million pounds (29.2 thousand metric tons), virtually the same as July 1984 and 8 percent above June 1985.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.4 million pounds (9690 metric tons), was 10 percent above July 1984 and 1 percent above June 1985.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production was 57.9 million pounds (26.3 thousand metric tons), 9 percent above July 1984 and was about the same as June 1985.

### FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with July 1984)

Ice cream -- 94.6 million gallons (358 million liters), up 5 percent.

Ice milk -- 36.8 million gallons (139 million liters), up 11 percent.

Sherbet -- 5.18 million gallons (19.6 million liters), up 5 percent.

### DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with July 1984)

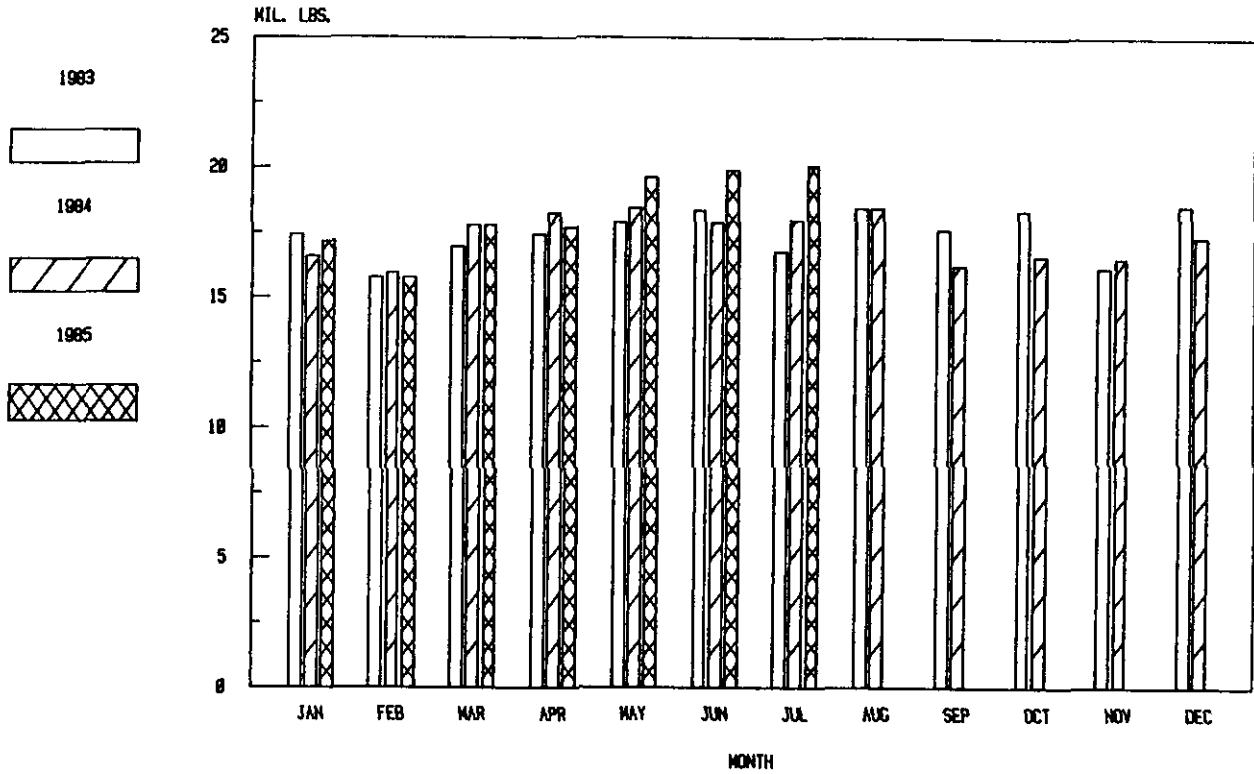
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 141 million pounds (64.2 thousand metric tons), up 33 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 11.5 million pounds (5240 metric tons), up 18 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.54 million pounds (1610 metric tons), up 27 percent.
