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AUGUST 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 91.3 million pounds (41.4 thousand metric tons), 30 percent above August 1984 but 4 percent below July 1985.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 249 million pounds (113 thousand metric tons), 22 percent above August 1984 but 1 percent below July 1985.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during August was 425 million pounds (193 thousand metric tons), 14 percent above August 1984 but 1 percent below July 1985.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 64.6 million pounds (29.3 thousand metric tons), 2 percent below August 1984 but no change from July 1985.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.7 million pounds (9850 metric tons), 3 percent above August 1984 and 2 percent above July 1985.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production was 55.6 million pounds (25.2 thousand metric tons), was up 1 percent from August 1984 but was 4 percent below July 1985.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with August 1984)

Ice cream -- 88.1 million gallons (333 million liters), up 1 percent.

Ice milk -- 34.2 million gallons (129 million liters), up 6 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.43 million gallons (16.8 million liters), down 2 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with August 1984)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 132 million pounds (60.0 thousand metric tons), up 50 percent.

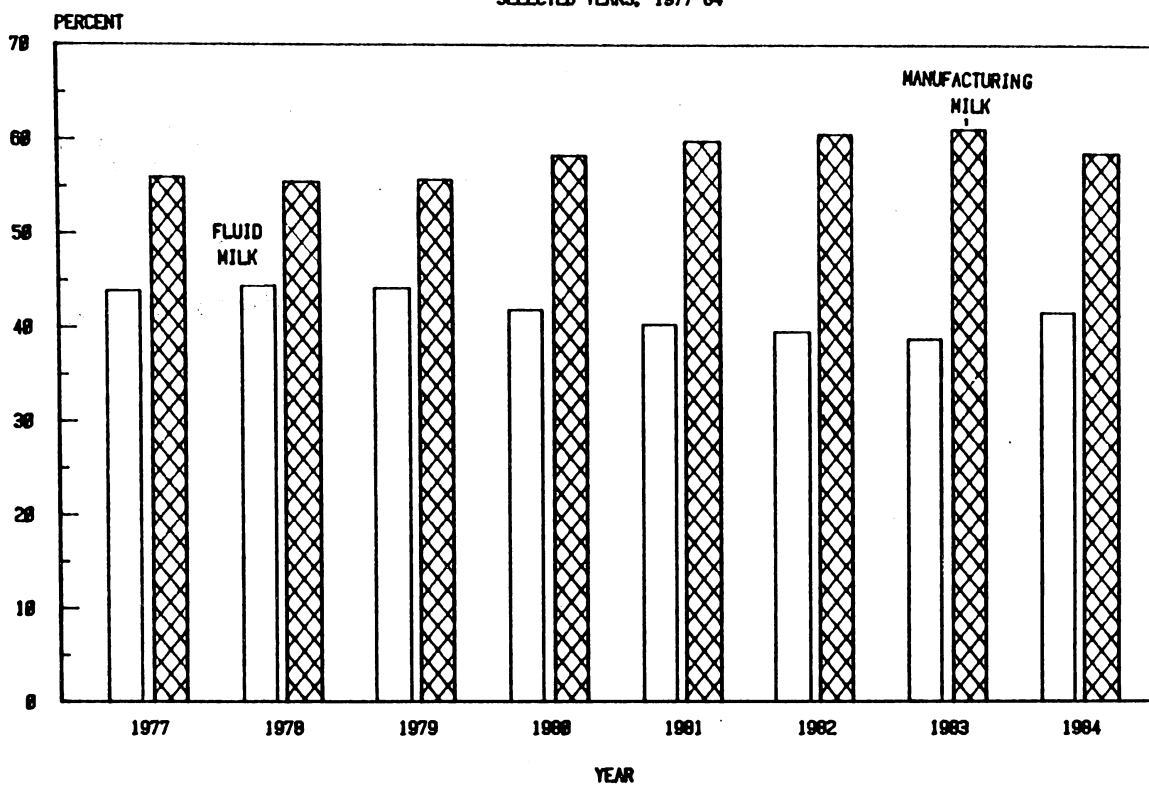
Dry whole milk -- 12.7 million pounds (5780 metric tons), up 56 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 2.76 million pounds (1250 metric tons), up 20 percent.
