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# Dairy Products



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## SEPTEMBER 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

**BUTTER** production was 93.6 million pounds (42.5 thousand metric tons), 39 percent above September 1984 and 3 percent above August 1985.

**AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE** production totaled 222 million pounds (101 thousand metric tons), 18 percent above September last year but 11 percent below August 1985.

**TOTAL CHEESE** output (excluding cottage cheese) during September was 404 million pounds (183 thousand metric tons), 13 percent above September 1984 but 5 percent below August 1985.

**CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE** production was 59.3 million pounds (26.9 thousand metric tons), 1 percent above last year but 8 percent below last month.

**LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE** production was 20.1 million pounds (9100 metric tons), 9 percent above September 1984 but 8 percent below August 1985.

**CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK** production, at 49.1 million pounds (22.3 thousand metric tons), was 6 percent below September 1984 and 12 percent below August 1985.

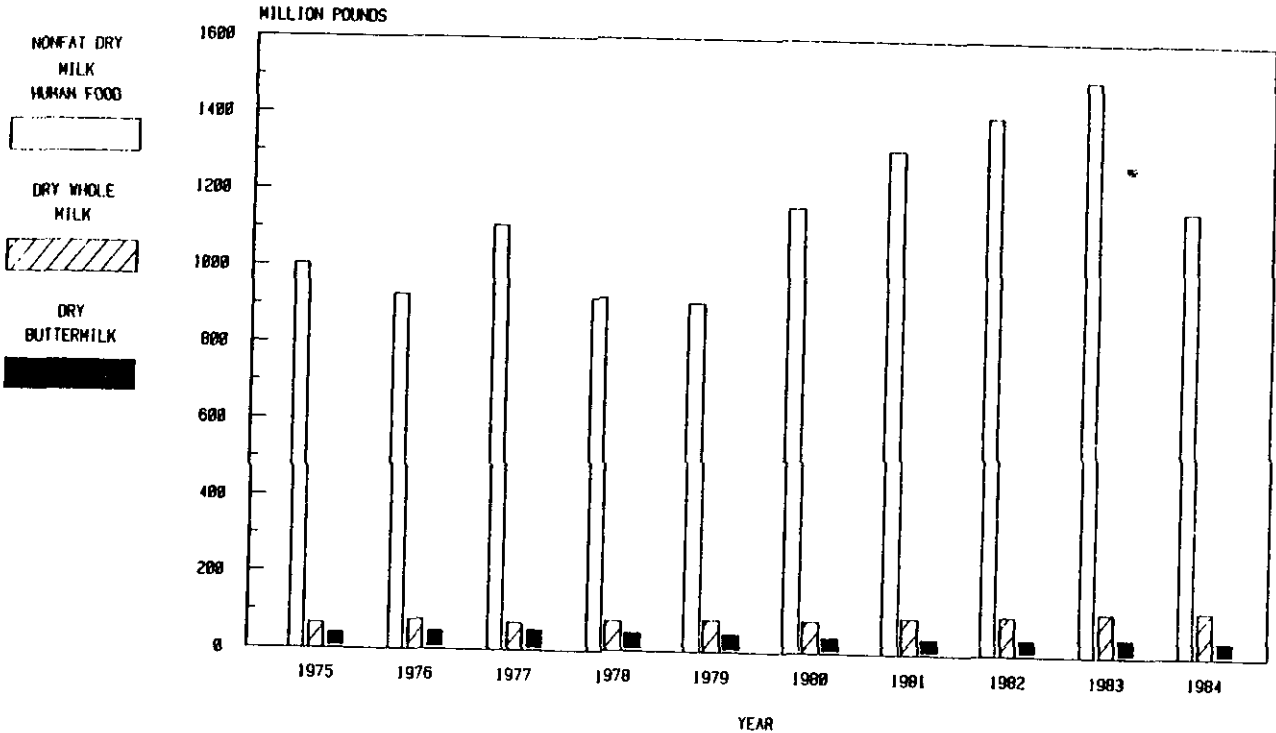
Ice cream -- 76.0 million gallons (288 million liters), up 2 percent.  
Ice milk -- 27.1 million gallons (103 million liters), up 11 percent.  
Sherbet -- 3.39 million gallons (12.8 million liters), down 5 percent.

### DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with September 1984)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 106 million pounds (48.0 thousand metric tons), up 49 percent.  
Dry whole milk -- 13.6 million pounds (6180 metric tons), up 31 percent.  
Dry buttermilk -- 3.33 million pounds (1510 metric tons), up 61 percent.
