OCTOBER 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 10.9 million pounds (49.4 thousand metric tons), 29 percent above October 1984 and 16 percent above September 1985.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 231 million pounds (105 thousand metric tons), 18 percent above October 1984 and 4 percent above September 1985.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during October was 429 million pounds (195 thousand metric tons), 13 percent above October 1984 and 6 percent above September 1985.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 60.5 million pounds (27.5 thousand metric tons), 1 percent below October last year but 2 percent above last month.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.1 million pounds (9560 metric tons), 9 percent above October 1984 and 5 percent above September 1985.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 51.2 million pounds (23.2 thousand metric tons), was 6 percent below last year but 4 percent above last month.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with October 1984)

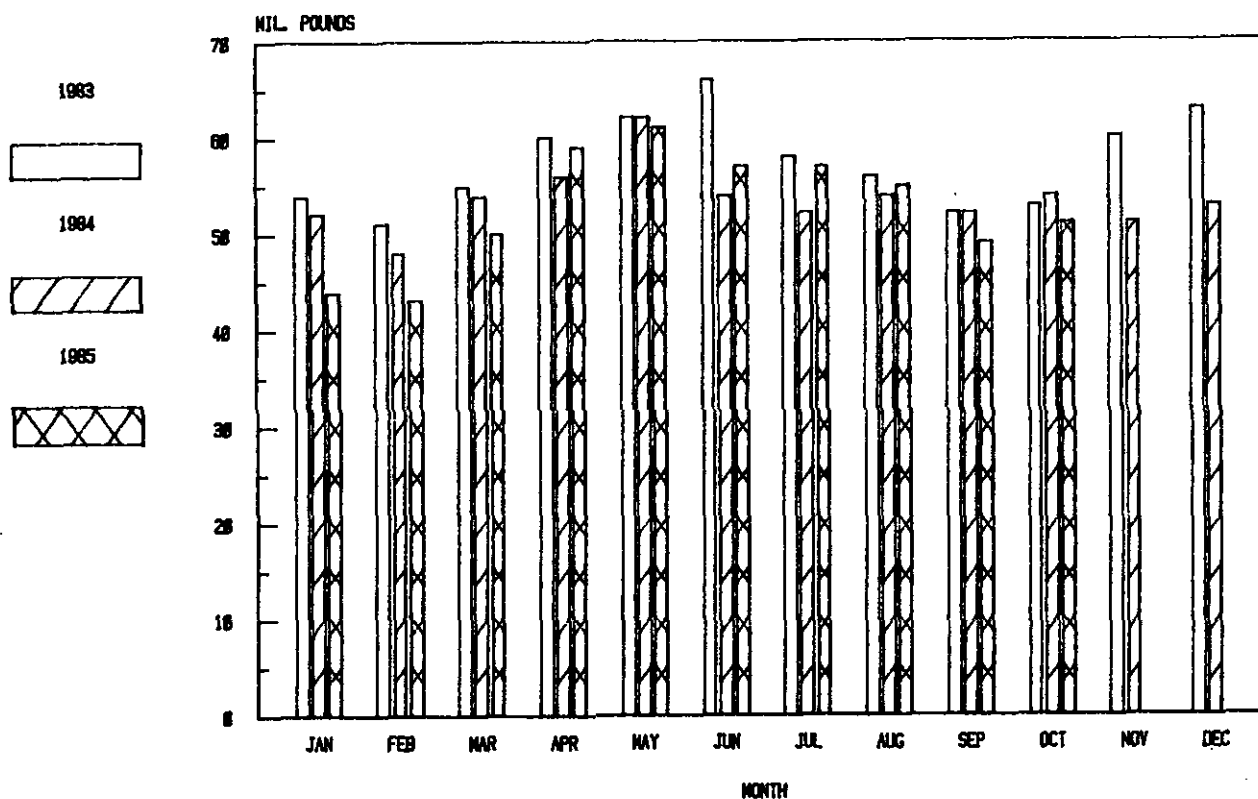
Ice cream -- 69.5 million gallons (263 million liters), up 1 percent.
Ice milk -- 24.7 million gallons (93.5 million liters), up 8 percent.
Sherbet -- 3.11 million gallons (11.8 million liters), down 1 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with October 1984)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 106 million pounds (48.0 thousand metric tons), up 48 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 10.4 million pounds (4700 metric tons), up 15 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.56 million pounds (2070 metric tons), up 62 percent.
