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NOVEMBER 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 101 million pounds (46.0 thousand metric tons), 27 percent above November 1984 but 7 percent below October 1985.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 222 million pounds (101 thousand metric tons), 19 percent above November 1984 but 4 percent below October 1985.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during November was 412 million pounds (187 thousand metric tons), 12 percent above November 1984 but 4 percent below October 1985.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 54.2 million pounds (24.6 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below November 1984 and 11 percent below October 1985.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 18.4 million pounds (8340 metric tons), 9 percent above November 1984 but 13 percent below October 1985.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 46.5 million pounds (21.1 thousand metric tons), was 9 percent below both November 1984 and October 1985.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with November 1984)

Ice cream -- 59.3 million gallons (224 million liters), down 3 percent.

Ice milk -- 19.2 million gallons (72.7 million liters), up 2 percent.

Sherbet -- 2.65 million gallons (10.0 million liters), down 6 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with November 1984)

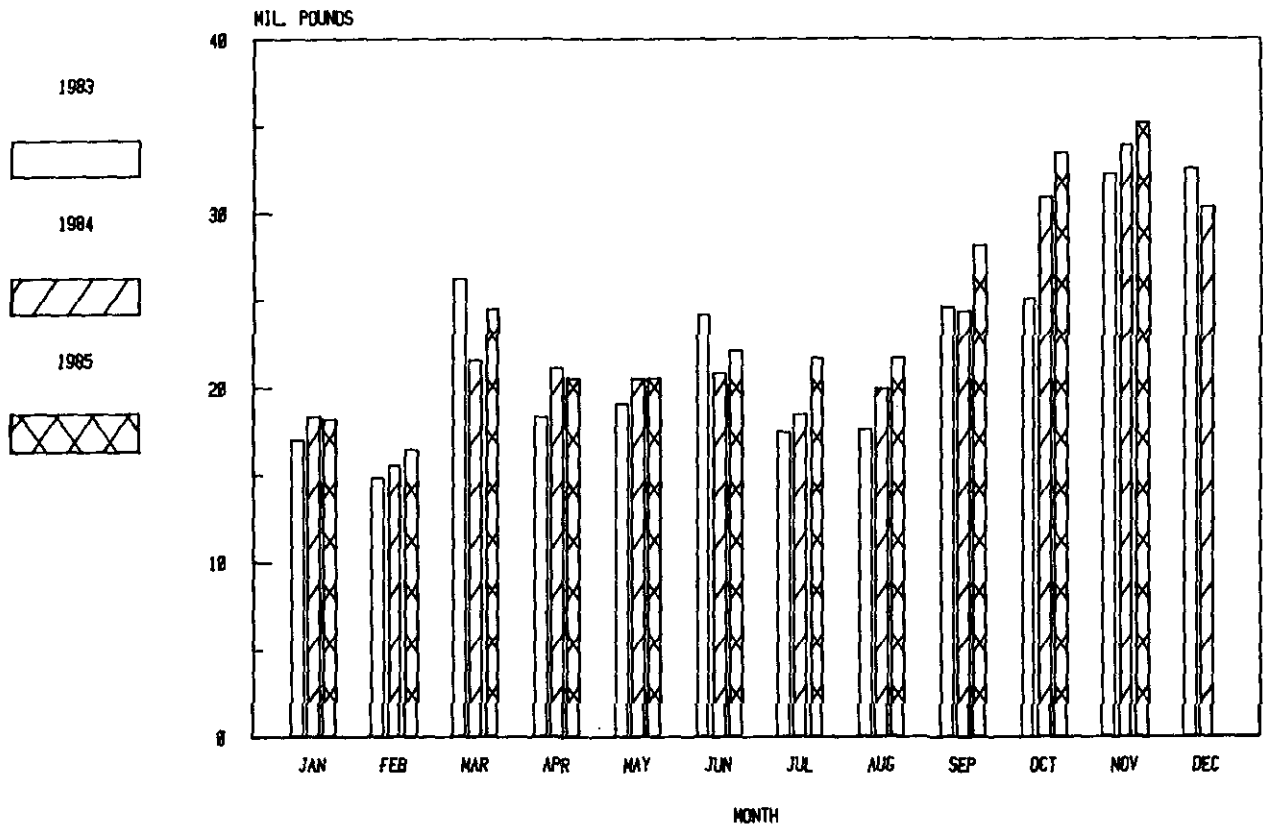
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 96.7 million pounds (43.9 thousand metric tons), up 43 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 11.9 million pounds (5410 metric tons), up 30 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.87 million pounds (1750 metric tons), up 60 percent.
