DECEMBER 1985 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 116 million pounds (52.6 thousand metric tons), 22 percent above December 1984 and 14 percent above November 1985.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 236 million pounds (107 thousand metric tons), 12 percent above December 1984 and 6 percent above November 1985.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during December was 435 million pounds (197 thousand metric tons), 10 percent above December 1984 and 6 percent above November 1985.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 50.8 million pounds (23.1 thousand metric tons), virtually the same as December 1984 but 6 percent less than November 1985.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 17.2 million pounds (7800 metric tons), 11 percent above December 1984 but 6 percent below November 1985.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 48.6 million pounds (22.0 thousand metric tons), was 9 percent below December 1984 but 5 percent above November 1985.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with December 1984)

Ice cream -- 58.5 million gallons (221 million liters), up 5 percent.

Ice milk -- 17.8 million gallons (67.5 million liters), up 6 percent.

Sherbet -- 2.71 million gallons (10.2 million liters), up 4 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with December 1984)

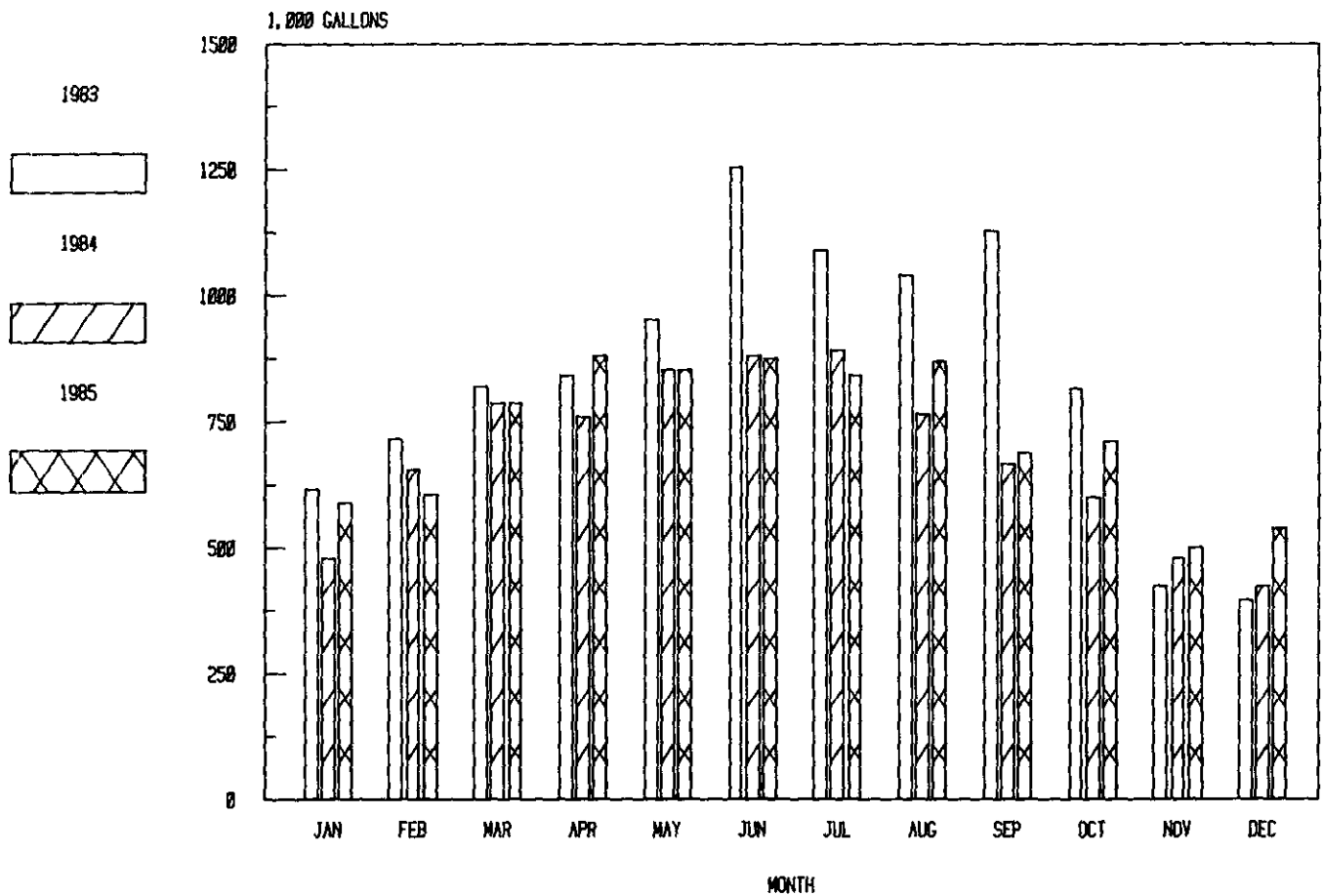
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 116 million pounds (52.5 thousand metric tons), up 35 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 8.68 million pounds (3940 metric tons), down 6 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.68 million pounds (1670 metric tons), down 3 percent.
