FEBRUARY 1986 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 119 million pounds (54.1 thousand metric tons), 11 percent above February 1985 but 12 percent below last month.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 227 million pounds (103 thousand metric tons), 13 percent above February 1985 but 5 percent below a month earlier.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during February was 399 million pounds (181 thousand metric tons), 12 percent above February a year ago but 6 percent less than last month.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 55.3 million pounds (25.1 thousand metric tons), 1 percent below February 1985 and 6 percent below last month.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 20.5 million pounds (9290 metric tons), 9 percent above February 1985 but 2 percent below last month.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 43.5 million pounds (19.8 thousand metric tons), was up 1 percent from both February 1985 and January 1986.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with February 1985)

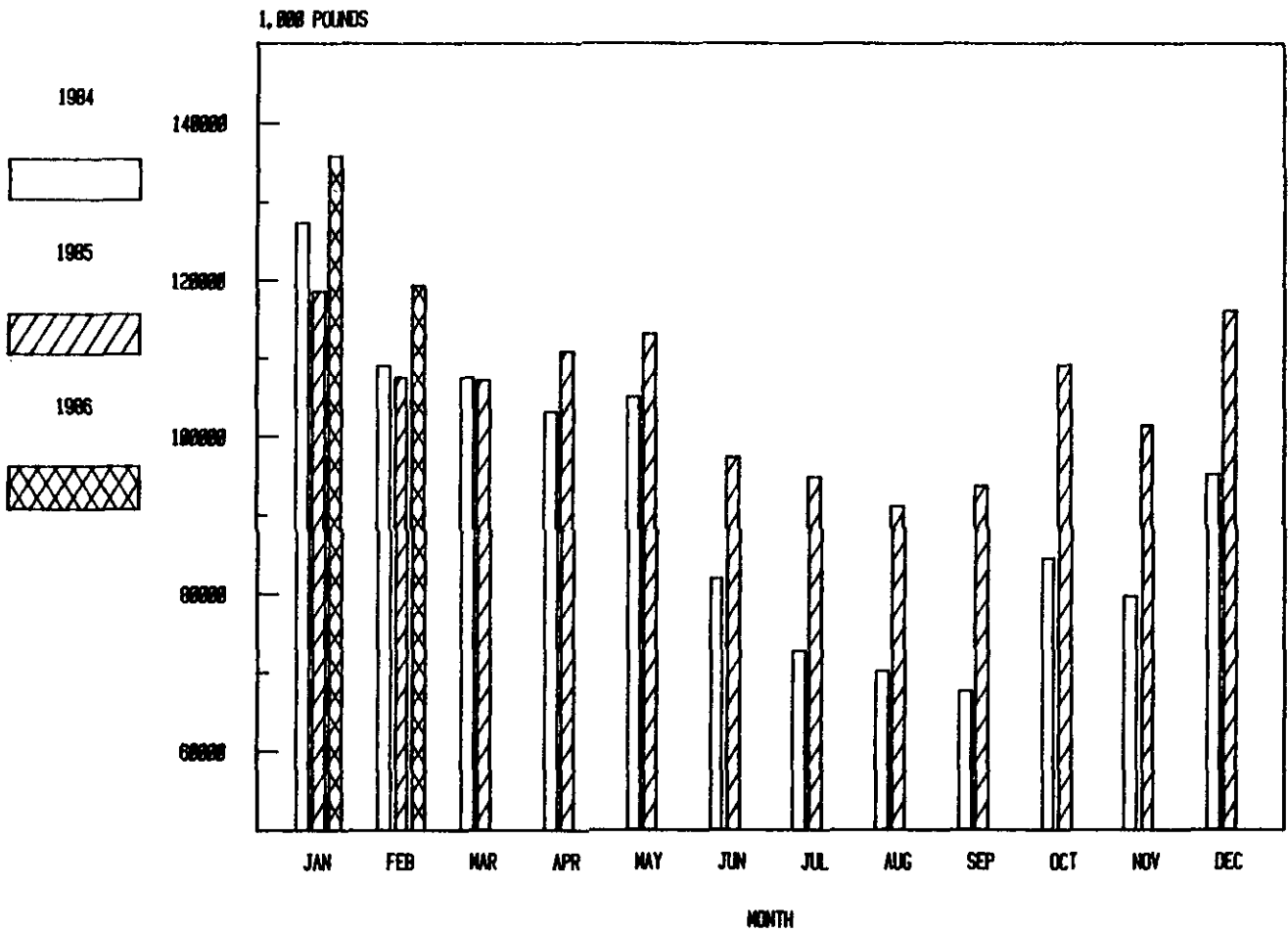
Ice cream -- 64.6 million gallons (245 million liters), up 9 percent.
Ice milk -- 19.6 million gallons (74.1 million liters), up 5 percent.
Sherbet -- 3.00 million gallons (11.3 million liters), up 6 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with February 1985)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 115 million pounds (52.0 thousand metric tons), up 26 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 10.7 million pounds (4840 metric tons), down 4 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 6.30 million pounds (2860 metric tons), up 48 percent.
