APRIL 1986 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 122 million pounds (55.2 thousand metric tons), 9 percent above April 1985 and 1 percent above March 1986.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 266 million pounds (121 thousand metric tons), 5 percent above April 1985 and 1 percent above March 1986.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during April was 461 million pounds (209 thousand metric tons), 7 percent above April 1985.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 59.1 million pounds (26.8 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below April 1985 and 1 percent below March 1986.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 28.7 million pounds (13.0 thousand metric tons), 36 percent above April 1985 and 32 percent above March 1986.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 52.6 million pounds (23.9 thousand metric tons), was 11 percent below April 1985 but 5 percent above March 1986.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with April 1985)

Ice cream -- 77.7 million gallons (294 million liters), up 2 percent.

Ice milk -- 29.5 million gallons (112 million liters), up 6 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.25 million gallons (16.1 million liters), up 1 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with April 1985)

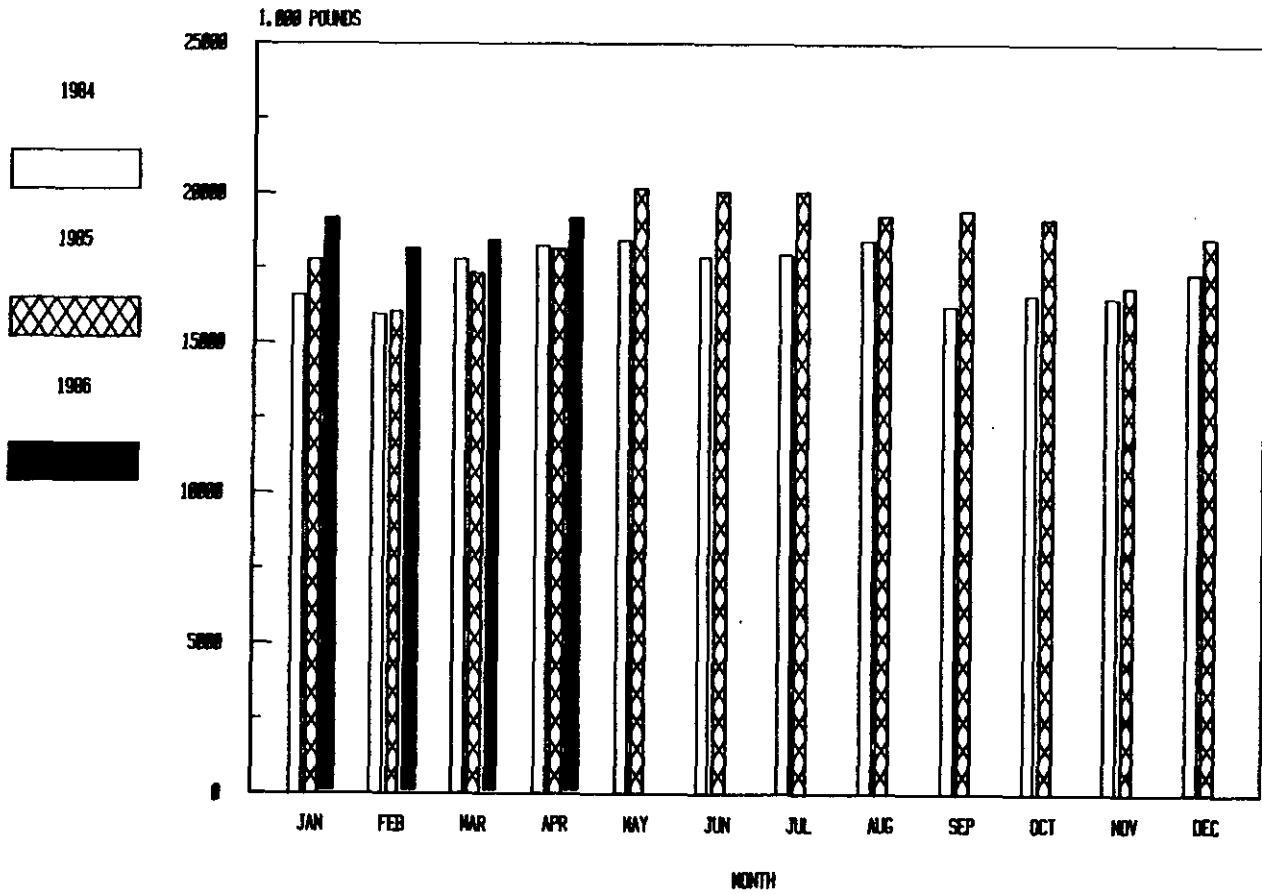
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 137 million pounds (62.2 thousand metric tons), up 11 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 10.1 million pounds (4580 metric tons), up 4 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 5.81 million pounds (2630 metric tons), up 35 percent.
