JUNE 1986 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 92.0 million pounds (41.7 thousand metric tons), 4 percent below June last year and 21 percent below May 1986.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 262 million pounds (119 thousand metric tons), 2 percent below June 1985 and 7 percent below last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during June was 459 million pounds (208 thousand metric tons), 4 percent above June 1985 but 4 percent below May 1986.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 59.3 million pounds (26.9 thousand metric tons), the same as June last year but 6 percent below May 1986.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 22.9 million pounds (10.4 thousand metric tons), 10 percent above June 1985 but 7 percent below May 1986.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 49.8 million pounds (22.6 thousand metric tons) was 14 percent below June last year and 8 percent below last month.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with June 1985)

Ice cream -- 90.6 million gallons (343 million liters), unchanged.

Ice milk -- 34.5 million gallons (130 million liters), up 9 percent.

Sherbet -- 5.69 million gallons (21.5 million liters), up 15 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with June 1985)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 137 million pounds (62.0 thousand metric tons), down 4 percent.

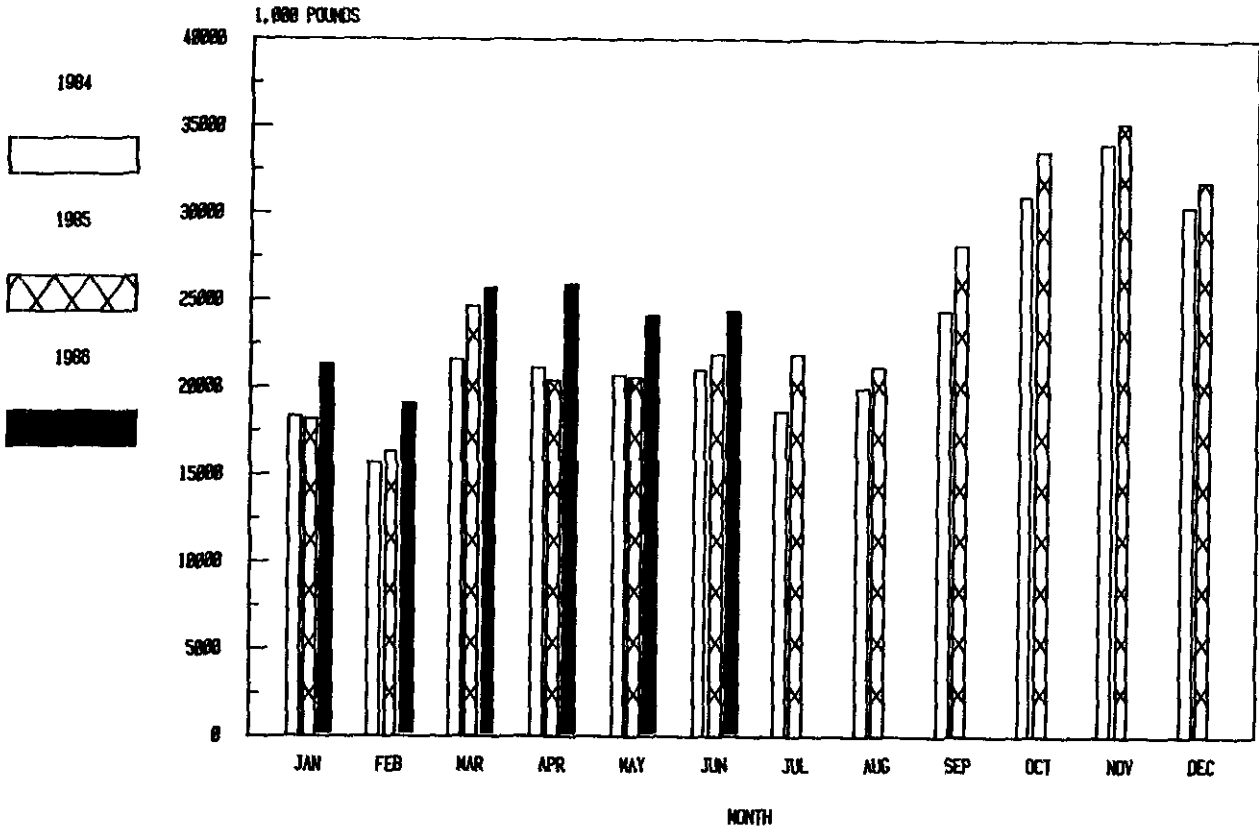
Dry whole milk -- 8.84 million pounds (4010 metric tons), up 1 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 5.10 million pounds (2320 metric tons), up 46 percent.
