SEPTEMBER 1986 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 79.2 million pounds (35.9 thousand metric tons), 14 percent below September 1985 but 10 percent above August 1986.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 202 million pounds (91.5 thousand metric tons), 7 percent below September last year and 10 percent below last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during September was 415 million pounds (188 thousand metric tons), 4 percent above September last year but 2 percent below August 1986.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 57.1 million pounds (25.9 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below September 1985 and 5 percent below August 1986.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.7 million pounds (9830 metric tons), 7 percent above September last year but 3 percent below last month.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 46.6 million pounds (21.2 thousand metric tons), was 2 percent below September last year and 3 percent below August 1986.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with September 1985)

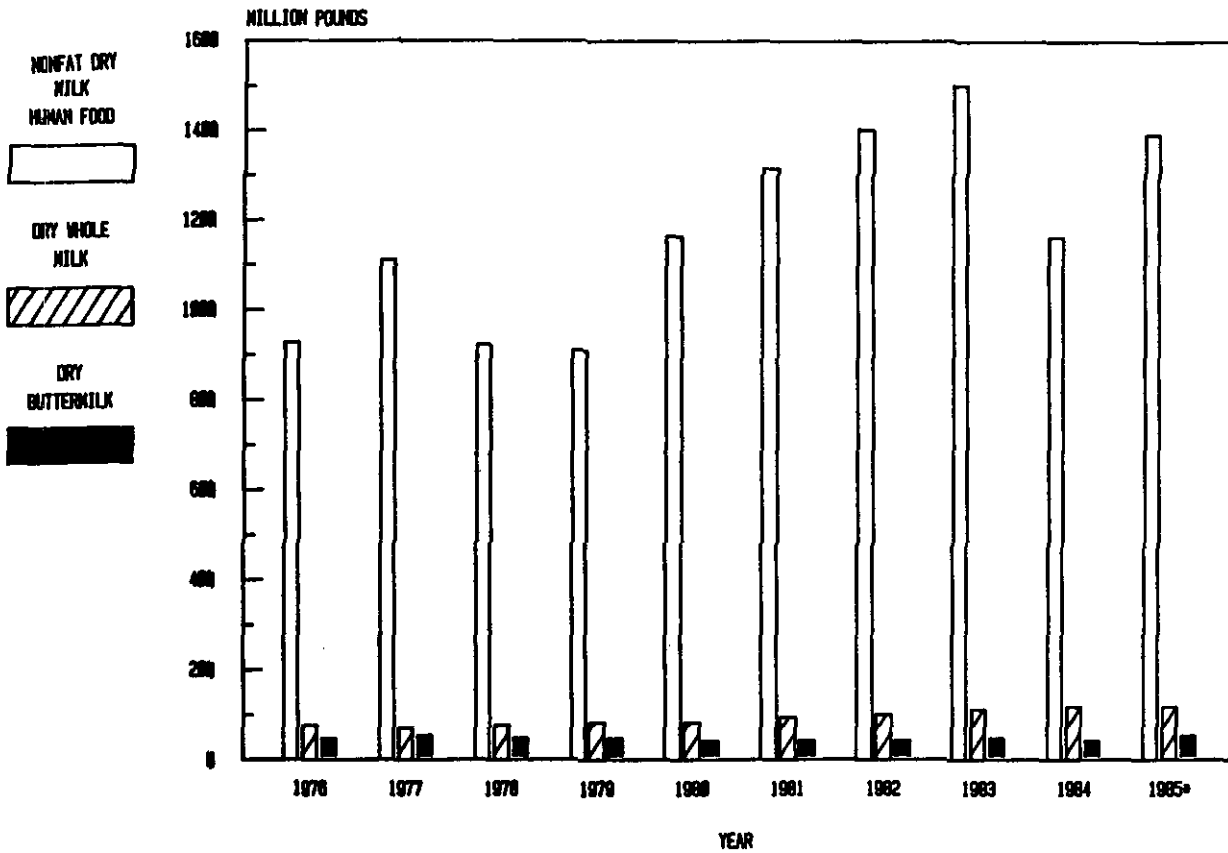
Ice cream -- 77.1 million gallons (292 million liters), unchanged.
Ice milk -- 26.3 million gallons (99.4 million liters), up 1 percent.
Sherbet -- 3.70 million gallons (14.0 million liters), up 4 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with September 1985)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 75.2 million pounds (34.1 thousand metric tons), down 30 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 11.4 million pounds (5180 metric tons), up 3 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.59 million pounds (2080 metric tons), up 29 percent.
