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NOVEMBER 1986 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 84.0 million pounds (38.1 thousand metric tons), 15 percent below November 1985 and 1 percent below October 1986.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 196 million pounds (88.7 thousand metric tons), 12 percent below November 1985 and 6 percent below October.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during November was 398 million pounds (180 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below November 1985 and 7 percent below October 1986.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 50.1 million pounds (22.7 thousand metric tons), 7 percent below November 1985 and 16 percent below October 1986.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 18.4 million pounds (8360 metric tons), 3 percent below November 1985, and 14 percent below October this year.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 42.8 million pounds (19.4 thousand metric tons), was 13 percent below November 1985 and 5 percent below October 1986.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with November 1985)

Ice cream -- 59.6 million gallons (226 million liters)-unchanged.
Ice milk -- 19.2 million gallons (72.8 million liters), up 8 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.54 million gallons (9.61 million liters), down 3 percent.

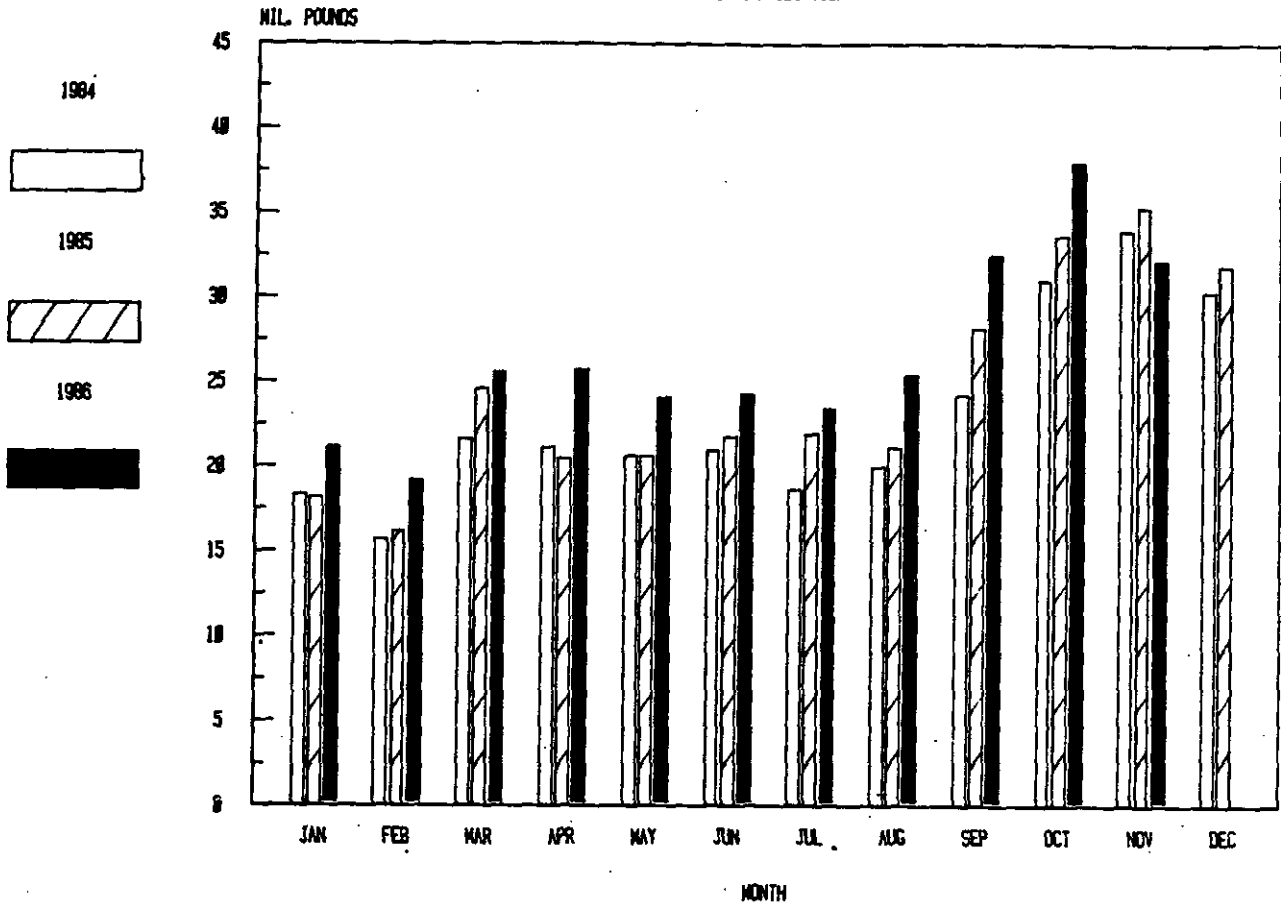
DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with November 1985)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 68.2 million pounds (30.9 thousand metric tons), down 29 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 10.2 million pounds (4650 metric tons), down 14 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 3.84 million pounds (1740 metric tons), down 9 percent.
