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DECEMBER 1986 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 101 million pounds (45.8 thousand metric tons), 13 percent below December 1985 but 20 percent above November 1986.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 223 million pounds (101 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below December 1985 but 14 percent above November 1986.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during December was 436 million pounds (198 thousand metric tons), the same as December 1985 and 10 percent above November 1986.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 507 million pounds (23.0 thousand metric tons), the same as December 1985 and 1 percent above November 1986.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 17.6 million pounds (7990 metric tons), 2 percent above December 1985 but 4 percent below November 1986.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 44.6 million pounds (20.2 thousand metric tons), was 8 percent below December 1985 but 4 percent above November 1986.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with December 1985)

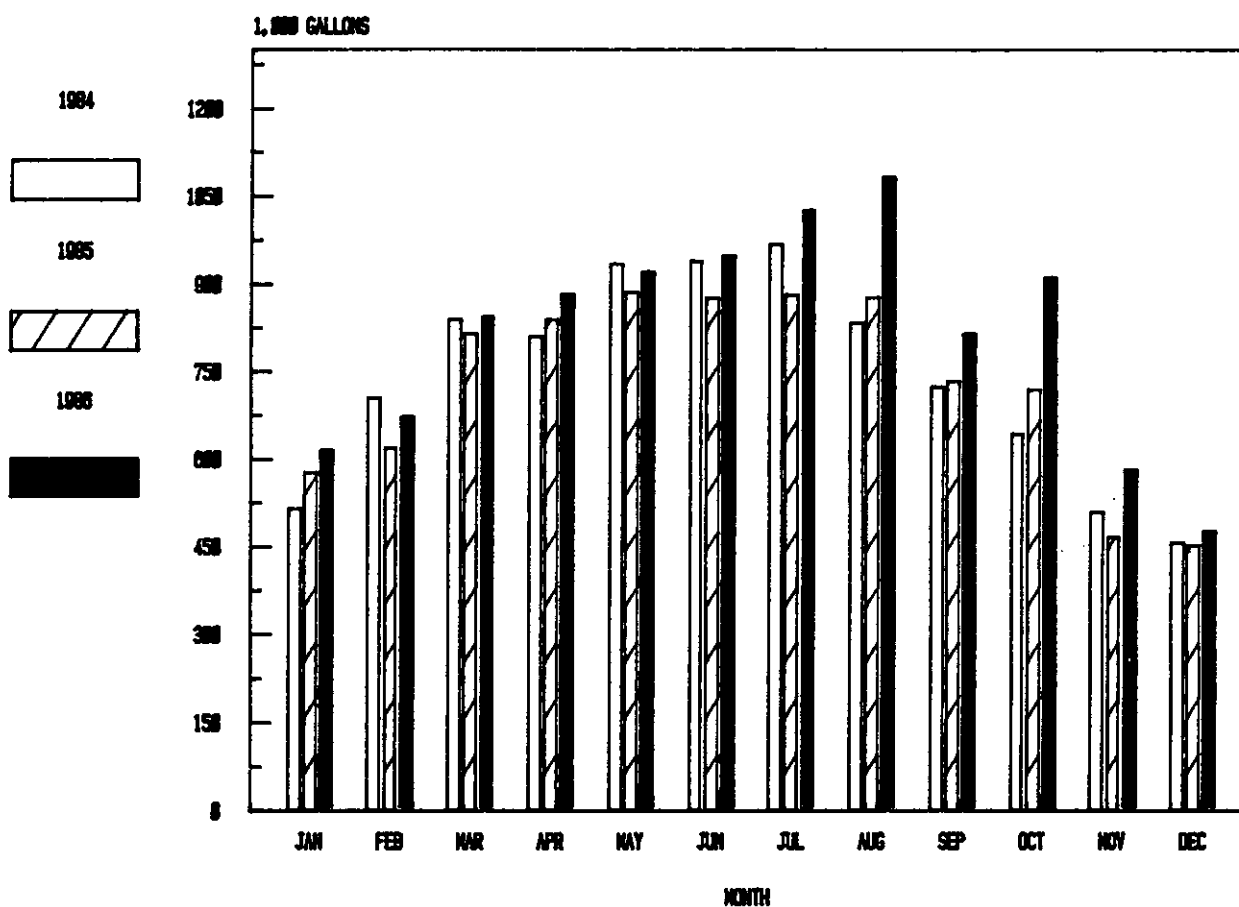
Ice cream -- 59.1 million gallons (224 million liters), up 1 percent.
Ice milk -- 19.6 million gallons (74.1 million liters), up 20 percent.
Sherbet -- 3.05 million gallons (11.6 million liters), up 5 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with December 1985)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 90.4 million pounds (41.0 thousand metric tons), down 22 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 9.18 million pounds (4170 metric tons), up 7 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 7.15 million pounds (3240 metric tons), up 49 percent.
