JANUARY 1987 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 109 million pounds (49.5 thousand metric tons), 20 percent below January 1986 but 8 percent above December 1986.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 220 million pounds (99.6 thousand metric tons), 8 percent below January 1986 and 1 percent below December 1986.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during January, was 414 million pounds (188 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below January 1986 and 5 percent below December.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 55.6 million pounds (25.2 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below January 1986 but 10 percent above December.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.1 million pounds (9590 metric tons), 1 percent above January 1986 and 20 percent above December 1986.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 39.8 million pounds (18.0 thousand metric tons), was 8 percent below January 1986 and 11 percent below December.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with January 1986)

Ice cream -- 57.6 million gallons (218 million liters), down 5 percent.
Ice milk -- 19.4 million gallons (73.6 million liters), down 1 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.91 million gallons (11.0 million liters), unchanged.

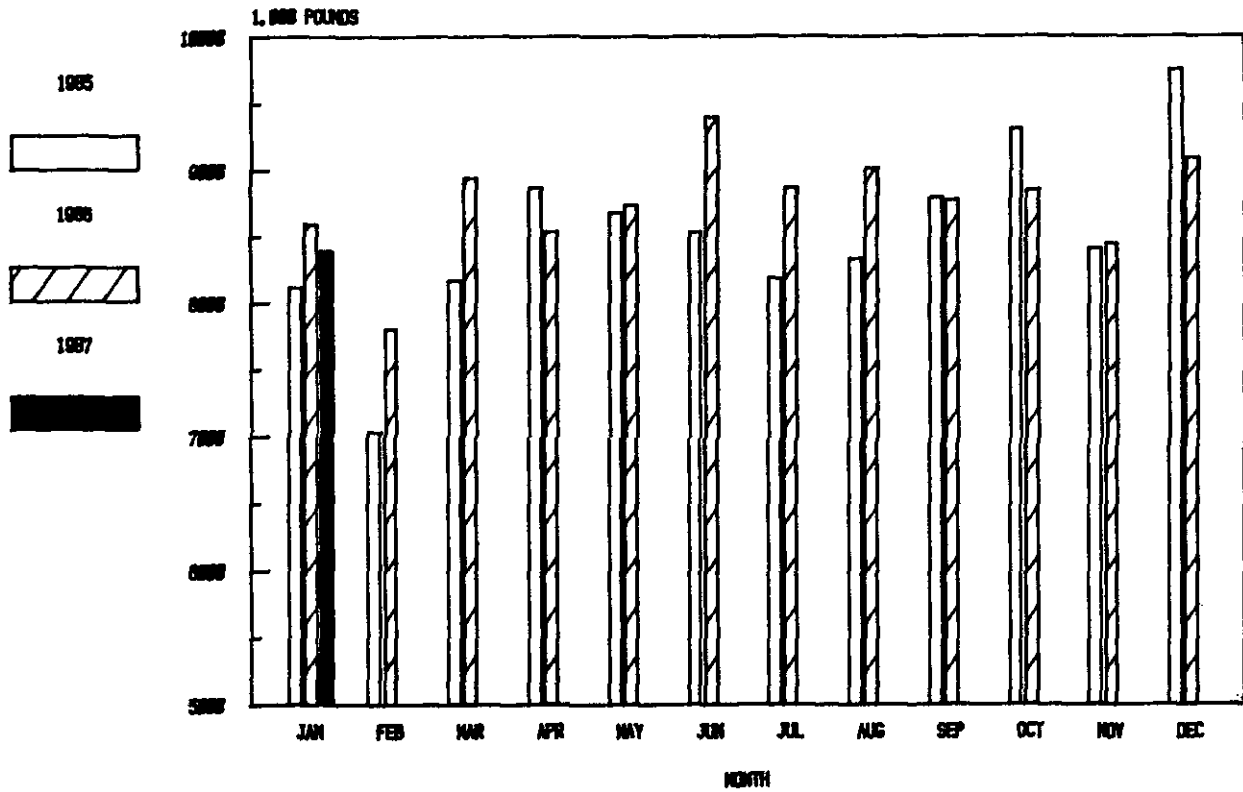
DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with January 1986)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 82.1 million pounds (37.2 thousand metric tons), down 34 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 11.3 million pounds (5130 metric tons), up 23 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 6.16 million pounds (2790 metric tons), down 16 percent.
