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FEBRUARY 1987 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 97.8 million pounds (44.4 thousand metric tons), 18 percent below February 1986 and 10 percent below January 1987.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 211 million pounds (95.8 thousand metric tons), 7 percent below February 1986 and 4 percent below January 1987.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during February was 401 million pounds (182 thousand metric tons), 1 percent above February 1986 but 3 percent below January 1987.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 52.7 million pounds (23.9 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below both February 1986 and January 1987.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.2 million pounds (9630 metric tons), 4 percent above February 1986 and was fractionally above January 1987.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 41.1 million pounds (18.7 thousand metric tons), was 6 percent below February 1986 but 3 percent above January 1987.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with February 1986)

Ice cream -- 66.0 million gallons (250 million liters), up 2 percent.
Ice milk -- 21.1 million gallons (79.8 million liters), up 8 percent.
Sherbet -- 2.94 million gallons (11.1 million liters), down 2 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with February 1986)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 80.3 million pounds (36.4 thousand metric tons), down 30 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 12.6 million pounds (5730 metric tons), up 18 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.81 million pounds (2180 metric tons), down 24 percent.

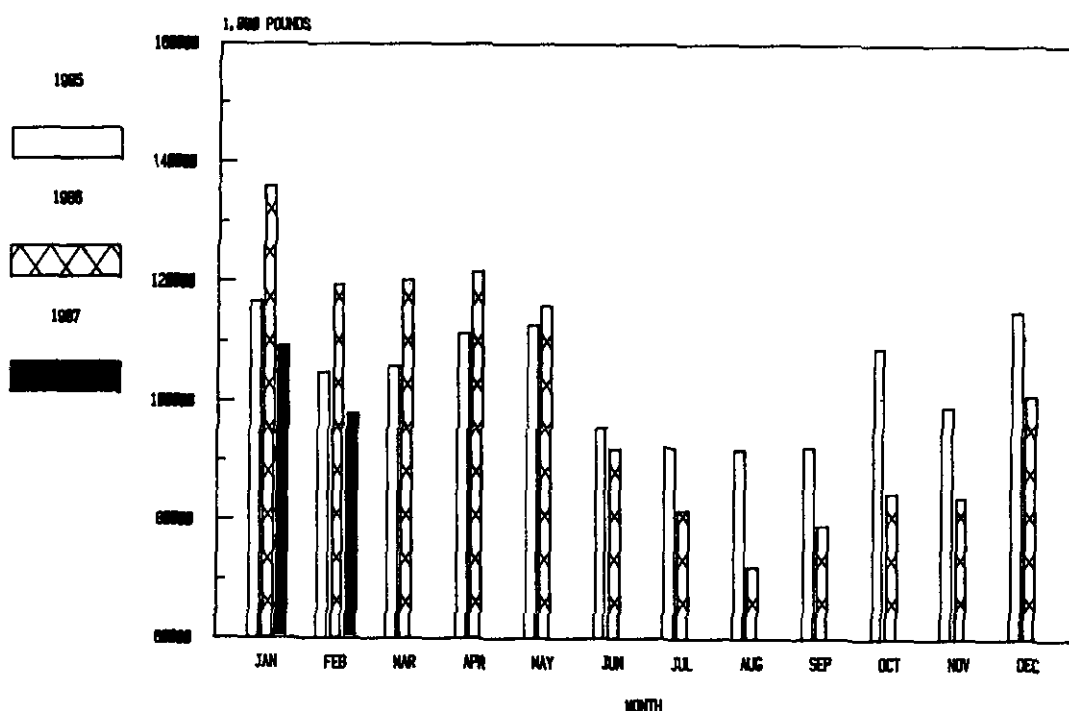
