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MARCH 1987 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 108 million pounds (48.8 thousand metric tons), 10 percent below March 1986 but 10 percent above February 1987.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 239 million pounds (108 thousand metric tons), 7 percent below March last year but 13 percent above last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during March was 456 million pounds (207 thousand metric tons), nearly the same as March 1986 but 14 percent above February this year.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 59.1 million pounds (26.8 thousand metric tons), 2 percent below last March but 12 percent above February this year.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 22.8 million pounds (10.4 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above March 1986 and 8 percent above February 1987.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 47.2 million pounds (21.4 thousand metric tons) was 7 percent below March last year but was 15 percent above the previous month.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with March 1986)

Ice cream (Hard) -- 76.5 million gallons (289 million liters), up 4 percent.

Ice milk -- 27.4 million gallons (104 million liters), up 6 percent.

Sherbet -- 3.70 million gallons (14.0 million liters), down 1 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with March 1986)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 87.8 million pounds (39.8 thousand metric tons), down 31 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 11.3 million pounds (5110 metric tons), down 4 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.82 million pounds (2190 metric tons), down 18 percent.

The results of the Butter Packaging Survey are shown on page 2.

BUTTER PACKAGING SURVEY

The results of the March survey showing February data are shown below. Percentages shown are based upon total butter available for disposition by butter manufacturers and printers. The butter for disposition includes interplant movement. It is the sum of butter printed, packaged in bulk form and used in other products.
