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## MAY 1987 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production during May was 102 million pounds (46.2 thousand metric tons), 11 percent less than May 1986 and 2 percent below April 1987.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 264 million pounds (120 thousand metric tons), 6 percent less than May last year but 7 percent more than last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during May was 485 million pounds (220 thousand metric tons), slightly more than 1986 and 6 percent more than April 1987 output.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 58.6 million pounds (26.6 thousand metric tons), 8 percent below May last year but was about the same as April this year.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 22.7 million pounds (10.3 thousand metric tons), was 10 percent below May 1986 but was virtually unchanged from April 1987.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 56.3 million pounds (25.5 thousand metric tons), was 5 percent above May 1986 and 12 percent above April 1987.

### FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with May 1986)

Ice cream (Hard) -- 82.3 million gallons (311 million liters), down 2 percent.

Ice milk -- 32.0 million gallons (121 million liters), down 2 percent.

Sherbet (Hard) -- 4.55 million gallons (17.2 million liters), down 8 percent.

### DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with May 1986)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 119 million pounds (53.8 thousand metric tons), down 20 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 11.1 million pounds (5010 metric tons), up 13 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 5.24 million pounds (2380 metric tons), down 21 percent.

BUTTER PACKAGING SURVEY

The results for March and April 1987 surveys and the 1986 annual survey are shown below. Total disposition of butter includes butter produced, interplant movement and bulk packaged butter removed from manufacturers own storage. Disposition is the sum of butter bulk packaged, printed, and used in other products for the monthly survey and is the total of production and interplant receipts for the annual data.
