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JUNE 1987 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 83.1 million pounds (37.7 thousand metric tons), 11 percent below June last year and 18 percent below May 1987.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 246 million pounds (112 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below June 1986 and 7 percent below the previous year.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during June was 464 million pounds (210 thousand metric tons), 1 percent above June 1986 but 4 percent below May 1987.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 59.1 million pounds (26.8 thousand metric tons), 1 percent below last year but 1 percent above May 1987.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 23.1 million pounds (10.5 thousand metric tons), was 2 percent below June 1986 but 2 percent above May 1987.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 52.9 million pounds (24.0 thousand metric tons), was 3 percent above June last year but 6 percent below last month.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with June 1986)

Ice cream -- 93.5 million gallons (354 million liters), up 6 percent.

Ice milk -- 35.7 million gallons (135 million liters), up 6 percent.

Sherbet -- 5.35 million gallons (20.2 million liters), down 1 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with June 1986)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 105 million pounds (47.5 thousand metric tons), down 22 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 12.4 million pounds (5610 metric tons), up 36 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.45 million pounds (2020 metric tons), down 11 percent.
