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AUGUST 1987 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 67.6 million pounds (30.7 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below August last year and 11 percent below July's corrected figures.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 209 million pounds (94.6 thousand metric tons), 5 percent below August 1986 and 13 percent below last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during August was 424 million pounds (192 thousand metric tons), about the same as last year but 8 percent below last month.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 57.5 million pounds (26.1 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below August last year and 3 percent below July 1987.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 23.0 million pounds (10.4 thousand metric tons), 2 percent below August 1986 but 2 percent above July 1987.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 46.1 million pounds (20.9 thousand metric tons) was 9 percent below August last year and 8 percent below last month.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with August 1986)

Ice cream -- 85.3 million gallons (323 million liters), down 2 percent.

Ice milk -- 33.3 million gallons (126 million liters), up 3 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.66 million gallons (17.7 million liters), down 2 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with August 1986)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 80.0 million pounds (36.3 thousand metric tons), down 11 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 12.0 million pounds (5440 metric tons), up 7 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.37 million pounds (1530 metric tons), down 17 percent.
