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## SEPTEMBER 1987 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 78.1 million pounds (35.4 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below September last year but 16 percent above August.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 206 million pounds (93.7 thousand metric tons), 4 percent above September 1986 but 1 percent below last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during September was 427 million pounds (194 thousand metric tons), 4 percent above September last year and 1 percent above last month.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 55.9 million pounds (25.3 thousand metric tons), 3 percent below both last year and last month.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 23.0 million pounds (10.4 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above September 1986 but nearly the same as August 1987.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 41.5 million pounds (18.8 thousand metric tons) was 8 percent below September 1986 and 10 percent below last month.

### FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with September 1986)

Ice cream -- 76.8 million gallons (291 million liters), up 3 percent.

Ice milk -- 28.0 million gallons (106 million liters), up 7 percent.

Sherbet -- 3.80 million gallons (14.4 million liters), up 4 percent.

### DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with September 1986)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 65.7 million pounds (29.8 thousand metric tons), down 12 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 12.5 million pounds (5650 metric tons), up 24 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.74 million pounds (1690 metric tons), down 19 percent.
