## JANUARY 1988 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 125 million pounds (56.6 thousand metric tons), 14 percent above both January and December 1987.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 226 million pounds (102 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above January a year ago but 3 percent below December.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during January was 433 million pounds (196 thousand metric tons), 5 percent above January a year earlier but 5 percent below December production.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 51.0 million pounds (23.1 thousand metric tons), 8 percent below January 1987 but 3 percent above December.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.0 million pounds (9500 metric tons), 1 percent below January 1987 but 13 percent above December.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 44.2 million pounds (20.1 thousand metric tons), 11 percent above January last year but 14 percent below December.

### FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with January 1987)

Ice cream (hard) -- 54.5 million gallons (206 million liters), down 5 percent.

Ice milk -- 18.8 million gallons (71.2 million liters), down 3 percent.

Sherbet -- 2.69 million gallons (10.2 million liters), down 8 percent.

### DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with January 1987)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 83.8 million pounds (38.0 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 13.6 million pounds (6150 metric tons), up 20 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 6.08 million pounds (2760 metric tons), down 1 percent.

BUTTER PACKAGING SURVEY

The results for November and December 1987 surveys are shown below. Total supply of butter includes butter produced, interplant movement and bulk packaged butter removed from manufacturers' owned storage. Supply is the sum of butter bulk packaged, printed, and used in other products.
