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FEBRUARY 1988 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 117 million pounds (53.1 thousand metric tons), 20 percent above February 1987 but 6 percent below January 1988.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 221 million pounds (100 thousand metric tons), 5 percent above February 1987 but 2 percent below January 1988.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during February was 429 million pounds (195 thousand metric tons), 7 percent above February 1987 but 1 percent below January 1988.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 53.7 million pounds (24.4 thousand metric tons), 2 percent above February 1987 and 5 percent above January 1988.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.6 million pounds (9820 metric tons), 2 percent above February 1987 and 3 percent above January 1988.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 41.6 million pounds (18.9 thousand metric tons), 1 percent above February 1987 but 6 percent below January 1988.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with February 1987)

Ice cream (hard) -- 63.2 million gallons (239 million liters), down 4 percent.

Ice milk -- 21.3 million gallons (80.5 million liters), up 1 percent.

Sherbet -- 3.17 million gallons (12.0 million liters), up 8 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with February 1987)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 85.8 million pounds (38.9 thousand metric tons), up 7 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 13.4 million pounds (6060 metric tons), up 6 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 5.69 million pounds (2580 metric tons), up 18 percent.
