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APRIL 1988 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 112 million pounds (50.6 thousand metric tons), 9 percent above April 1987 but 4 percent below March 1988.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 252 million pounds (114 thousand metric tons), 3 percent above both April last year and last month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) during April was 473 million pounds (215 thousand metric tons), 2 percent above April 1987 but 2 percent below March this year.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 54.9 million pounds (24.9 thousand metric tons), 6 percent below both April last year and last month.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 23.1 million pounds (10.5 thousand metric tons), 1 percent below April 1987 and 3 percent below March 1988.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK production, at 54.4 million pounds (24.7 thousand metric tons) 11 percent above April last year and 3 percent above March 1988.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with April 1987)

Ice cream (Hard) -- 73.6 million gallons (279 million liters), down 6 percent.

Ice milk -- 29.6 million gallons (112 million liters), up 2 percent.

Sherbet -- 4.63 million gallons (17.5 million liters), up 5 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with April 1987)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 103 million pounds (46.5 thousand metric tons), down 5 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 15.7 million pounds (7140 metric tons), up 67 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 6.08 million pounds (2760 metric tons), up 13 percent.
