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## JUNE 1988 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 91.7 million pounds in June, up 13 percent from June 1987 but 15 percent below May 1988.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 245 million pounds, about the same as June 1987 but 5 percent below the previous month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) was 474 million pounds, 2 percent above June 1987 but 3 percent below May 1988.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 57.0 million pounds, 6 percent below last year and 1 percent below May 1988.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 25.6 million pounds, 3 percent above June 1987 and 2 percent above May 1988.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK, 54.5 million pounds, 1 percent above June 1987 and 6 percent above May 1988.

### FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with June 1987)

Ice cream (Hard) -- 94.1 million gallons, up 2 percent.

Ice milk -- 39.1 million gallons, up 6 percent.

Sherbet (Hard) -- 5.84 million gallons, up 7 percent.

### DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with June 1987)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 105 million pounds, down 4 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 14.1 million pounds, up 14 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 4.45 million pounds, no change.
