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JULY 1988 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 75.9 million pounds in July, 1 percent above July 1987 but 17 percent below June 1988.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 236 million pounds, about the same as July 1987 but 4 percent below the previous month.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) was 454 million pounds, the same as July 1987 but 4 percent below June 1988.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 56.0 million pounds, 5 percent below July 1987 and 2 percent below June 1988.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 24.7 million pounds, 6 percent above July 1987 but 4 percent below June 1988.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK, 44.8 million pounds, 9 percent below July 1987 and 18 percent below June 1988.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with July 1987)

Ice cream (Hard) -- 88.8 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Ice milk -- 37.5 million gallons, up 1 percent.

Sherbet (Hard) -- 5.76 million gallons, up 9 percent.

DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with July 1987)

Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 79.5 million pounds, down 20 percent.

Dry whole milk -- 14.8 million pounds, up 29 percent.

Dry buttermilk -- 3.22 million pounds, down 17 percent.

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BUTTER PACKAGING SURVEY

The results for May and June 1988 surveys are shown below. Total supply of butter includes butter produced, interplant movement and bulk packaged butter removed from manufacturers' owned storage. Supply is the sum of butter bulk packaged, printed, and used in other products.
