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## OCTOBER 1989 HIGHLIGHTS

**BUTTER** production was 92.7 million pounds, virtually unchanged from October 1988 but 13 percent above September 1989.

**AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE** production totaled 207 million pounds, 6 percent below October 1988 but 3 percent above September 1989.

**TOTAL CHEESE** output (excluding cottage cheese) was 453 million pounds, 4 percent below October 1988 but 1 percent above September 1989.

**CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE** production was 45.3 million pounds, 10 percent below October 1988 and 2 percent below September 1989.

**LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE** production was 24.0 million pounds, 3 percent above October 1988 but 2 percent below September 1989.

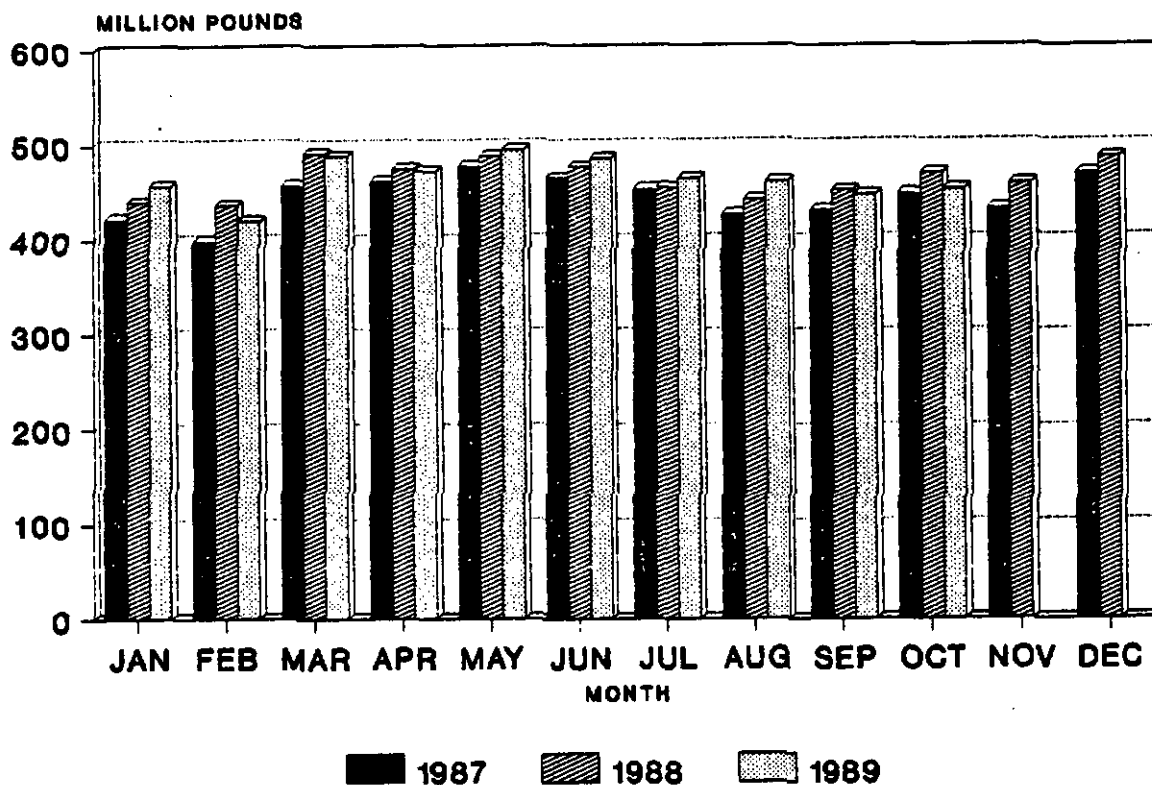
**CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK**, 37.3 million pounds, 13 percent below October 1988 and 1 percent below September 1989.

**FROZEN DESSERTS:** (Comparisons with October 1988)  
Ice cream (Hard) — 60.2 million gallons, virtually unchanged.  
Ice milk — 26.9 million gallons, up 3 percent.  
Sherbet (Hard) — 3.17 million gallons, down 6 percent.

**DRY MILK PRODUCTS:** (Comparisons with October 1988)  
Nonfat dry milk for human food — 48.0 million pounds, down 16 percent.  
Dry whole milk — 17.6 million pounds, up 24 percent.  
Dry buttermilk — 3.49 million pounds, down 8 percent.
