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DECEMBER 1989 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 108 million pounds in December, 4 percent below December 1988 but 15 percent above November 1989.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 229 million pounds, 3 percent below December 1988 but 9 percent above November 1989.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) was 483 million pounds, 1 percent below December 1988 but 6 percent above November 1989.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 40.0 million pounds, 14 percent below December 1988 and 8 percent below November 1989.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 21.0 million pounds, virtually unchanged from December 1988 but 7 percent below November 1989.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED WHOLE MILK, at 38.8 million pounds, was 15 percent below December 1988 but 15 percent above November 1989.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with December 1988)
Ice cream (Hard) -- 51.0 million gallons, down 5 percent.
Ice milk -- 25.3 million gallons, up 14 percent.
Sherbet (Hard) -- 2.92 million gallons, down 5 percent.

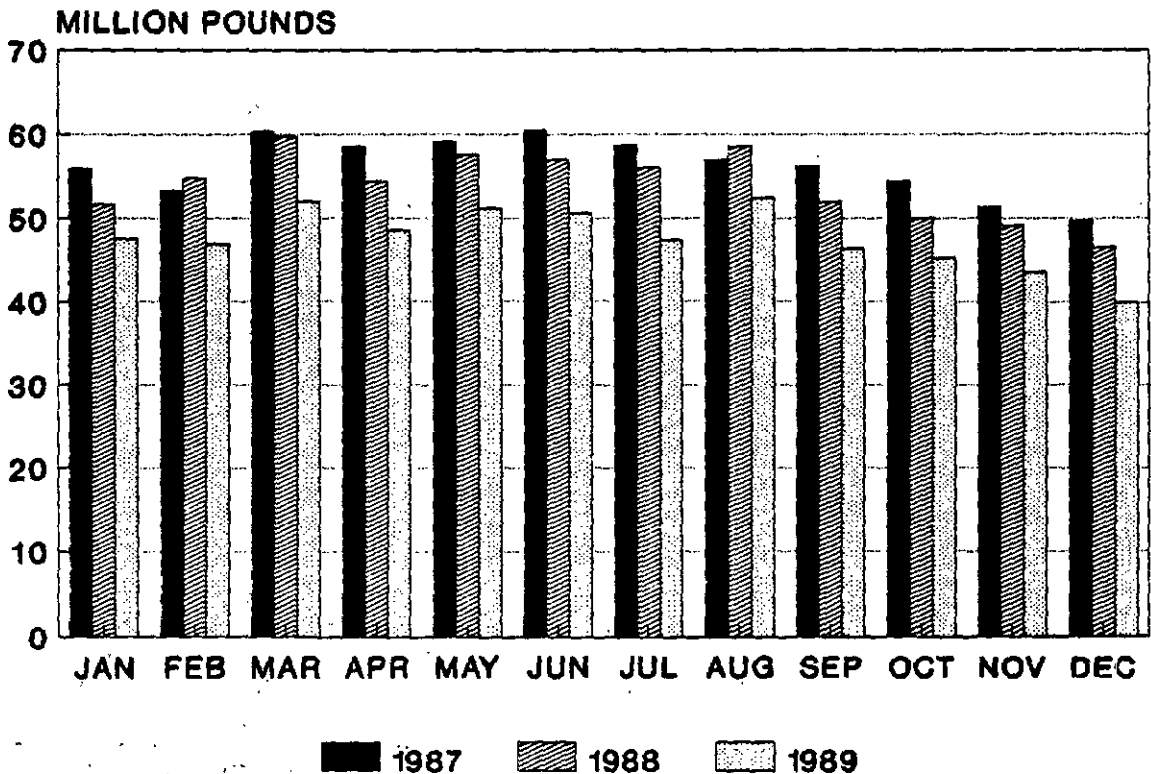
DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with December 1988)
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 62.5 million pounds, down 18 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 17.6 million pounds, up 24 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.66 million pounds, down 17 percent.
