National
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JUNE 1990 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 95.9 million pounds in June, 1 percent below June 1989 and 20 percent below May 1990.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 253 million pounds, 8 percent above June 1989 but 5 percent below May 1990.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) was 529 million pounds, 9 percent above June 1989 but 3 percent below May 1990.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 45.4 million pounds 11 percent below June 1989 and 9 percent below May 1990.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 26.6 million pounds, virtually unchanged from June 1989 but 5 percent below May 1990.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED MILK production at 53.7 million pounds was 3 percent above June 1989 and 7 percent above May 1990.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (Comparisons with June 1989)
Ice cream (hard) —78.4 million gallons, down 3 percent.
Ice milk —35.8 million gallons, down 13 percent.
Sherbet (hard) —4.81 million gallons, down 14 percent.

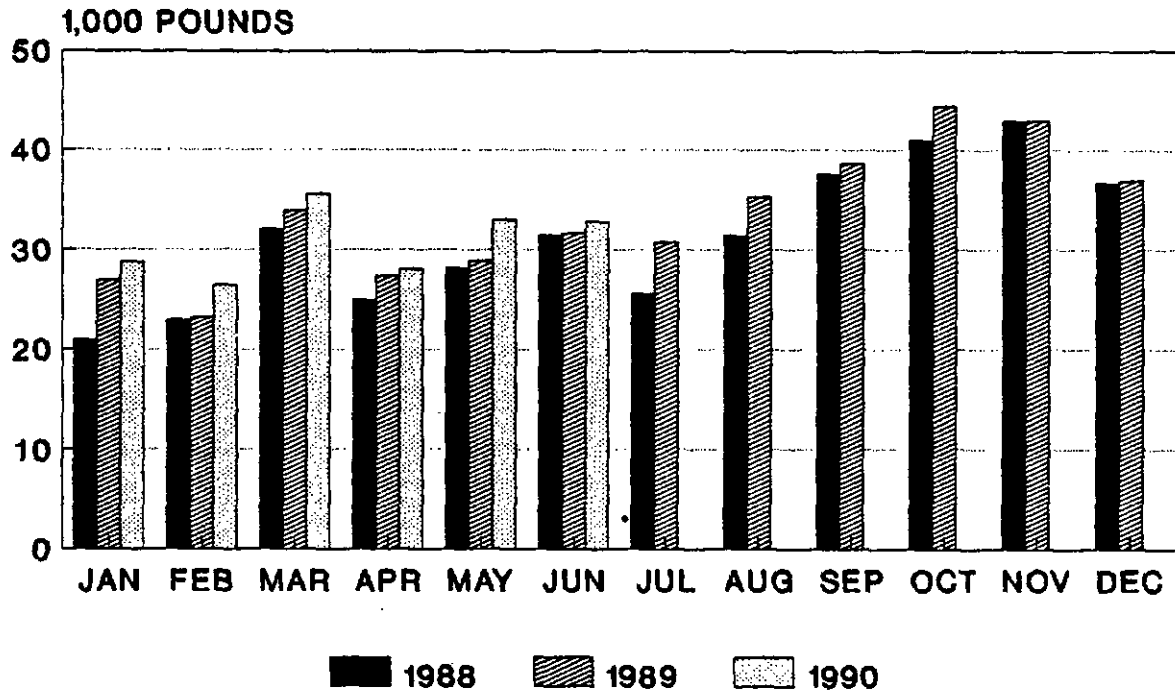
DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (Comparisons with June 1989)
Nonfat dry milk for human food —83.3 million pounds, up 5 percent.
Dry whole milk —15.6 million pounds, up 13 percent.
Dry buttermilk —3.55 million pounds down 15 percent.
