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OCTOBER 1990 HIGHLIGHTS

BUTTER production was 105 million pounds in October, 10 percent above October 1989 and 24 percent above September 1990.

AMERICAN TYPE CHEESE production totaled 237 million pounds, 13 percent above October 1989 and 7 percent above September 1990.

TOTAL CHEESE output (excluding cottage cheese) was 504 million pounds, 9 percent above October 1989 and 6 percent above September 1990.

CREAMED COTTAGE CHEESE production was 44.5 million pounds, 1 percent below October 1989 but 4 percent above September 1990.

LOWFAT COTTAGE CHEESE production was 25.0 million pounds, 3 percent above October 1989 and 4 percent above September 1990.

CANNED EVAPORATED AND CONDENSED MILK production at 49.1 million pounds was 37 percent above October 1989 and 5 percent above September 1990.

FROZEN DESSERTS: (comparisons with October 1989)
Ice cream (hard) -- 61.9 million gallons, up 6 percent.
Ice milk -- 26.4 million gallons, down 7 percent.
Sherbet (hard) -- 3.09 million gallons, up 2 percent.

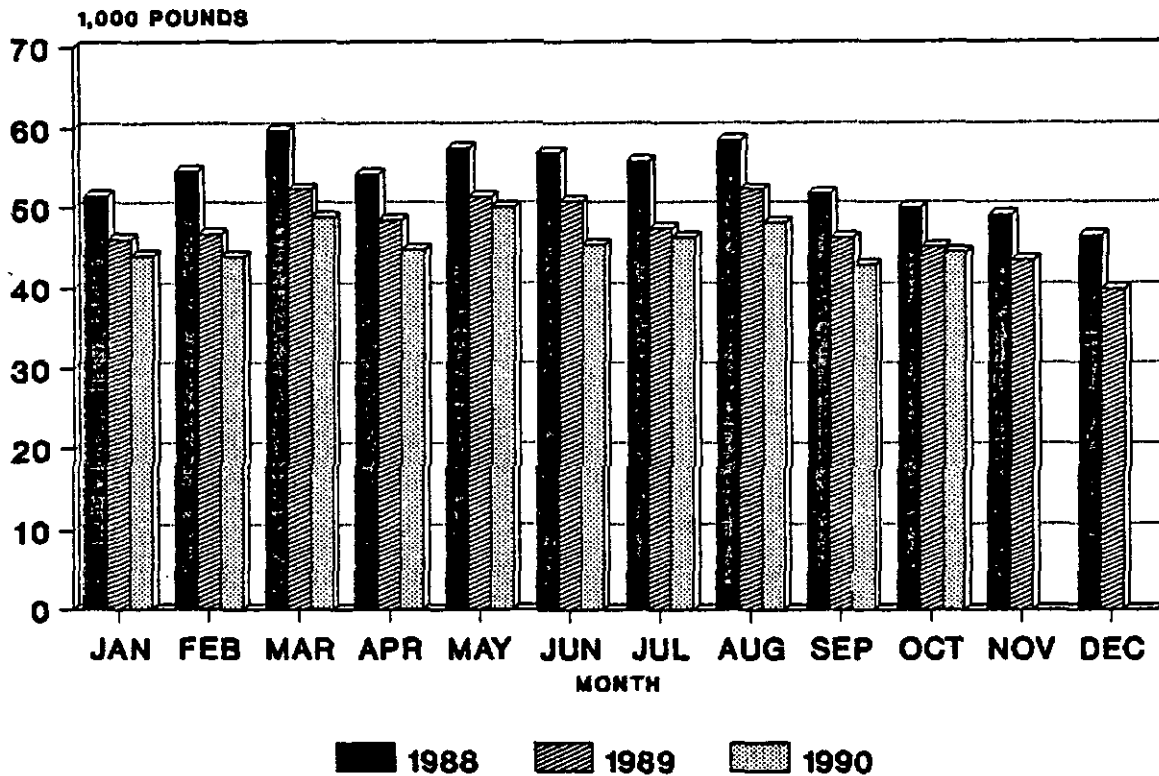
DRY MILK PRODUCTS: (comparisons with October 1989)
Nonfat dry milk for human food -- 55.2 million pounds, up 15 percent.
Dry whole milk -- 11.6 million pounds, down 31 percent.
Dry buttermilk -- 4.80 million pounds, up 32 percent.
