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February 1994 Highlights

Butter production was 120 million pounds in February, 14 percent below February 1993 and down 9 percent from January 1994.

American type cheese production totaled 221 million pounds, 1 percent below February 1993 and 11 percent below January 1994.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 507 million pounds, 4 percent above February 1993 but 6 percent below January 1994.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 32.5 million pounds, 5 percent below February 1993 but slightly above January 1994.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 24.9 million pounds, 4 percent below February 1993 but 5 percent above January 1994.

Canned evaporated and condensed milk production at 41.3 million pounds was 10 percent above February 1993 and 14 percent above January 1994.

Frozen desserts: (comparisons with February 1993)

Ice cream (hard)---60.0 million gallons, up 8 percent.

Ice milk---23.0 million gallons, down 1 percent.

Sherbet(hard)---3.30 million gallons, up 7 percent.

Dry milk products: (comparisons with February 1993)

Nonfat dry milk for human food---85.4 million pounds, up 2 percent.

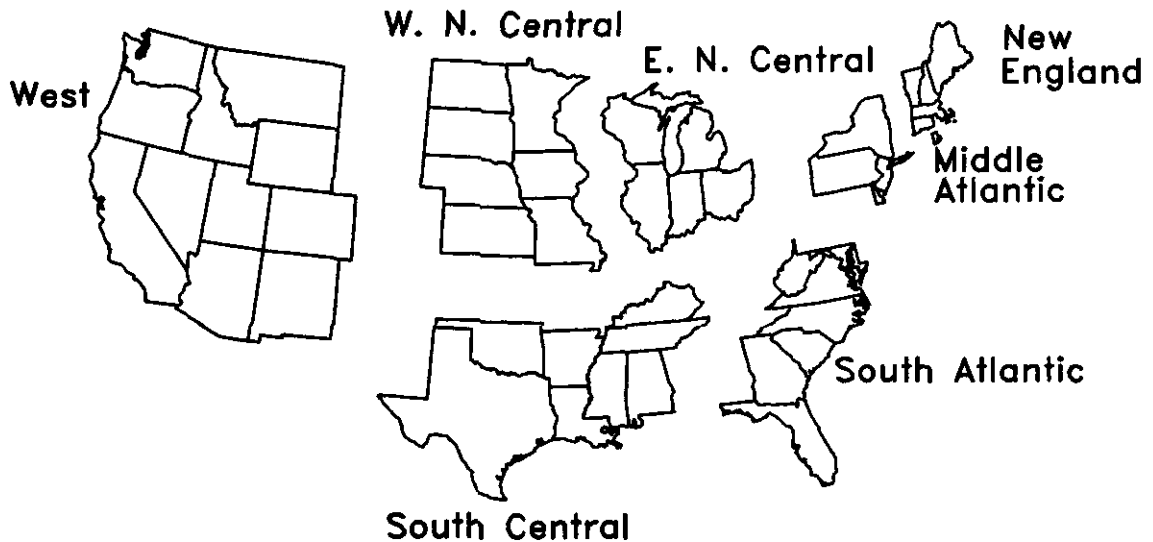
Dry whole milk---8.45 million pounds, down 35 percent.

Dry buttermilk---5.01 million pounds, up 5 percent.

In the event we are not able to publish a region for confidentially reasons, it will be combined with other regions when possible. For example, the New England region if not publishable separately will be combined with Middle Atlantic to form North Atlantic. If neither can be published, then both will be combined with South Atlantic to publish Atlantic. The West North Central and East North Central will be combined, if necessary, to form North Central. In the event that neither could be published, then we will combined with South to publish Central. Some tables will have only or two regions shown, therefore the regions may not add to the United States total.

Procedures and Reliability: Estimates included in this report are based on data provided by manufacturers of these products. There are 32 States where the State Departments of Agriculture assist in collection of data, which eliminates duplicate reporting and reduces respondent burden. Data are collected by mail, personal and telephone interviews following the close of each month. There were 1,603 manufacturers that made one or more products in 1992. Reports are generally received from all dairy plants in States with small numbers of plants. In States with large numbers of plants, survey procedures are designed to obtain reports from all large plants and from a sample of small plants. Estimates are based upon returns from about 70 percent of the plants which account for 70 to 90 percent of the total production of major dairy products.

Revision Policy: Monthly production estimates are not subject to revision until the annual Dairy Products is published each May. An attempt is made to get information from all plants for preparing these estimates. Stocks data are subject to revision the following month.

The next "Dairy Products" report will be released at 3 p.m. ET on May 6, 1994.

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
