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June 1994 Highlights

Butter production was 102 million pounds in June, slightly below June 1993 and 14 percent below May 1994.

American type cheese production totaled 267 million pounds, 1 percent below June 1993 but 1 percent above May 1994.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 563 million pounds, slightly above June 1993 but 4 percent below May 1994.

Creamed cottage cheese production was 36.2 million pounds, 2 percent above June 1993 and 1 percent above May 1994.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 27.5 million pounds, 2 percent below June 1993 but slightly above May 1994.

Canned evaporated and condensed milk production, at 49.3 million pounds, was 17 percent above June 1993 but 12 percent below May 1994.

Frozen desserts: (comparisons with June 1993)

Ice cream (hard)---82.8 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Ice milk----35.7 million gallons, up 6 percent.

Sherbet(hard) ---5.04 million gallons, down slightly.

Dry milk products: (comparisons with June 1993)

Nonfat dry milk for human food--116 million pounds, up 24 percent.

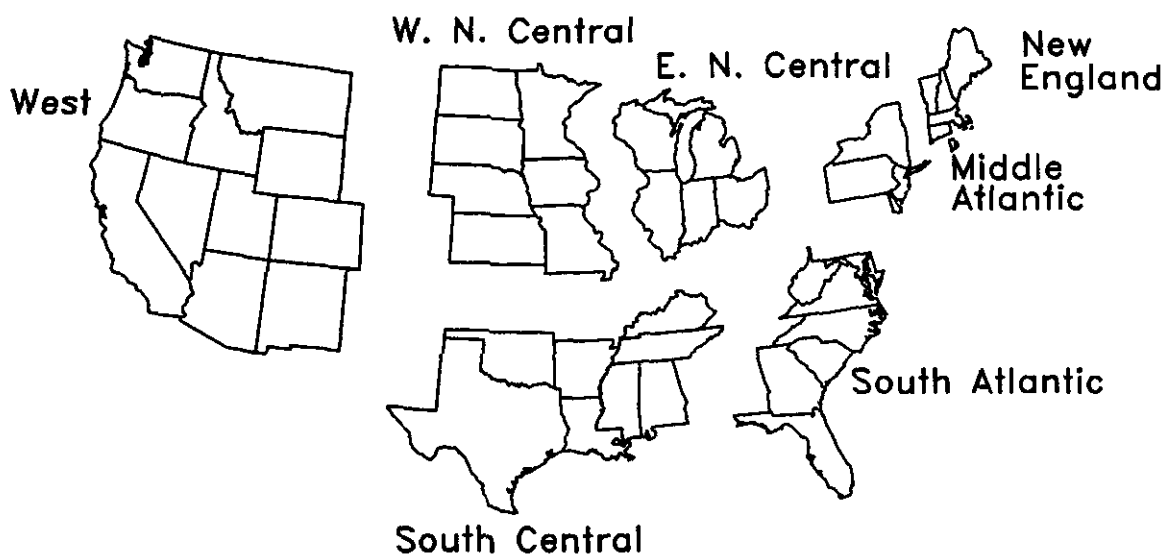
Dry whole milk----12.1 million pounds, down 7 percent.

Dry buttermilk----3.92 million pounds, up slightly.

If we are not able to publish a region for confidentially reasons, it will be combined with other regions when possible. For example, the New England region if not publishable separately will be combined with Middle Atlantic to form North Atlantic. If neither can be published, then both will be combined with South Atlantic to publish Atlantic. The West North Central and East North Central will be combined, if necessary, to form North Central. In the event that neither could be published, they will combined with South Central to publish Central. Some tables will have only one or two regions shown, therefore the regions may not add to the United States total.

Procedures and Reliability: Estimates included in this report are based on data provided each month by manufacturers of these products. In 32 States, the State Departments of Agriculture assist in collection of data, which eliminates duplicate reporting and reduces respondent burden. Data are collected by mail, personal and telephone interviews following the close of each month. There were 1,534 manufacturers that made one or more products in 1993. Each month, reports are generally received from all dairy plants in States with small numbers of plants. In States with large numbers of plants, survey procedures are designed to obtain monthly reports from all large plants and from a sample of small plants. Monthly estimates are based upon returns from about 70 percent of the plants which account for 70 to 90 percent of the total production of major dairy products.

Revision Policy: Monthly production estimates are not subject to revision until the annual Dairy Products is published each May. An attempt is made to get information from all plants for preparing these estimates. Stocks data are subject to revision the month following the preliminary estimate.

The next "Dairy Products" report will be released at 3 p.m. ET on September 6, 1994.

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
