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## July 1995 Highlights

**Butter** production was 82.9 million pounds in July, 2 percent below July 1994 and 17 percent below June 1995.

**American type cheese** production totaled 259 million pounds, 3 percent above July 1994 but 2 percent below June 1995.

**Total cheese** output (excluding cottage cheese) was 561 million pounds, up 2 percent from July 1994 but 5 percent below June 1995.

**Creamed cottage cheese** production was 32.1 million pounds, 10 percent below July 1994 and 2 percent below June 1995.

**Lowfat cottage cheese** production was 27.9 million pounds, 1 percent above July 1994 but 4 percent below June 1995.

**Canned evaporated and condensed milk** production at 36.2 million pounds was 15 percent below July 1994 and 21 percent below June 1995.

### **Frozen desserts:** (comparisons with July 1994)

Ice cream (hard) --- 81.7 million gallons, down 1 percent.

Ice cream (lowfat) --- 35.4 million gallons, down 4 percent.

Sherbet (hard) --- 5.30 million gallons, up 5 percent.

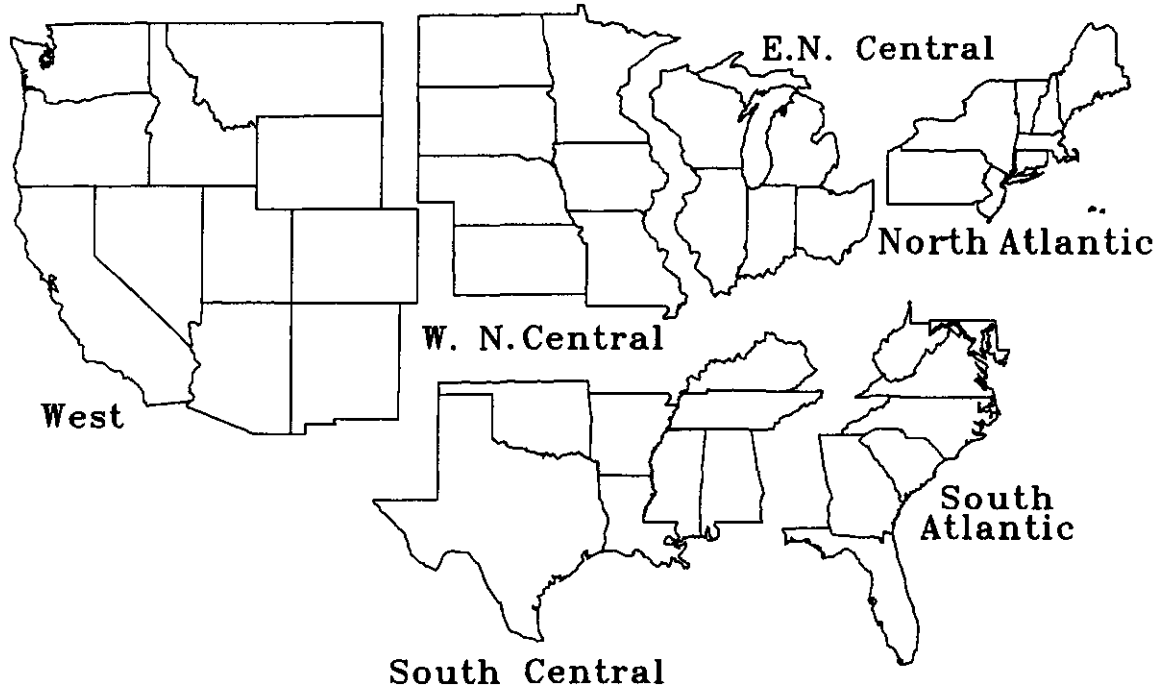
### **Dry milk products:** (comparisons with July 1994)

Nonfat dry milk for human food --- 102 million pounds, up 3 percent.

Dry whole milk --- 11.7 million pounds, down 31 percent.

Dry buttermilk --- 2.85 million pounds, down 1 percent.

If we are not able to publish a region for confidentiality reasons, it will be combined with other regions when possible. For example, if North Atlantic can not be published, then it will be combined with South Atlantic to publish Atlantic. The West North Central and East North Central will be combined, if necessary, to form North Central. In the event that neither could be published, they will be combined with South Central to publish Central. Some tables will have only one or two regions shown, therefore the regions may not add to the United States total.

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**Procedures and Reliability:** Estimates included in this report are based on data provided each month by manufacturers of these products. In 32 States, the State Departments of Agriculture assist in collection of data, which eliminates duplicate reporting and reduces respondent burden. Data are collected by mail, personal and telephone interviews following the close of each month. There were 1,531 manufacturers that made one or more products in 1994. Each month, reports are generally received from all dairy plants in States with small numbers of plants. In States with large numbers of plants, survey procedures are designed to obtain monthly reports from all large plants and from a sample of small plants. Monthly estimates are based upon returns from about 70 percent of the plants which account for 70 to 90 percent of the total production of major dairy products.

**Revision Policy:** Monthly production estimates are subject to revision the month following the preliminary estimates. Annual revisions are also published in the "Dairy Products" report published each May. In preparing the annual report, an attempt is made to get information from all plants.

The next "Dairy Products" report will be released at 3 p.m. ET on October 5, 1995.

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
