



Dairy Products

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January 2001 Highlights

American type cheese production totaled 301 million pounds, 5.1 percent below January 2000 but 0.4 percent above December 2000.

Total cheese output (excluding cottage cheese) was 678 million pounds, 1.2 percent below January 2000 and 1.7 percent below December 2000.

Cream cottage cheese production was 30.1 million pounds, 8.9 percent above January 2000 and 7.0 percent above December 2000.

Lowfat cottage cheese production was 29.2 million pounds, 3.5 percent above January 2000 and 11.8 percent above December 2000.

Butter production was 128 million pounds in January, 9.7 percent below January 2000 but 10.8 percent above December 2000.

Frozen dessert: (comparisons with January 2000)

Ice cream, Regular (hard) --- 62.8 million gallons, up 4.6 percent.

Ice cream, Lowfat (total) --- 24.1 million gallons, up 17.6 percent.

Ice cream, Nonfat (hard) --- 2.02 million gallons, down 17.9 percent.

Sherbet (hard) --- 3.47 million gallons, up 4.9 percent.

Frozen Yogurt (total) --- 6.27 million gallons, up 14.6 percent.

Dry milk products: (comparisons with January 2000)

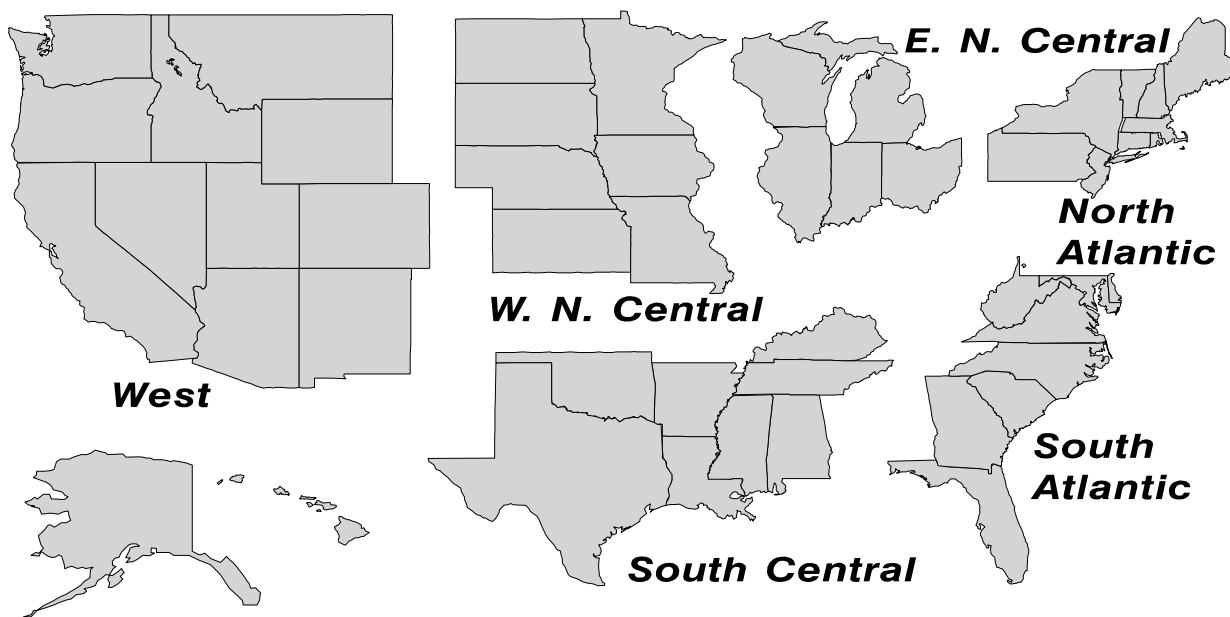
Nonfat dry milk for human food --- 117 million pounds, down 12.1 percent.

Dry whole milk --- 5.09 million pounds, down 41.8 percent.

Dry buttermilk --- 5.26 million pounds, down 8.8 percent.

If we are not able to publish a region for confidentiality reasons, it will be combined with other regions when possible. For example, if North Atlantic can not be published, then it will be combined with South Atlantic to publish Atlantic. The West North Central and East North Central will be combined, if necessary, to form North Central. In the event that neither could be published, they may be combined with South Central to publish Central. Some tables will have only limited regions shown, therefore the regions may not add to the United States total.

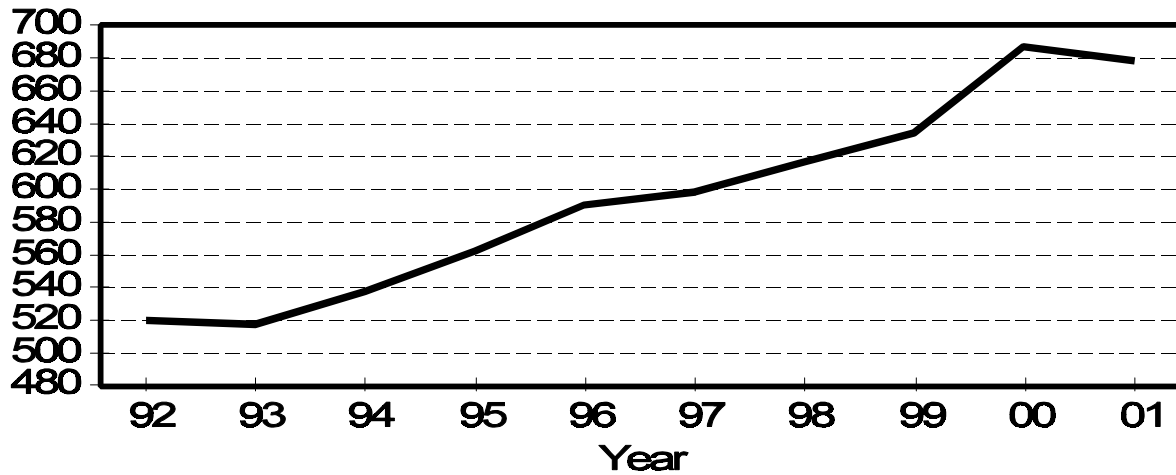

Procedures and Reliability: Estimates included in this report are based on data provided each month by manufacturers of these products. In 32 States, the State Departments of Agriculture assist in collection of data, which eliminates duplicate reporting and reduces respondent burden. Data are collected by mail, personal and telephone interviews following the close of each month. There were 1,258 manufacturers that made one or more products in 1999. Each month, reports are generally received from all dairy plants in States with small numbers of plants. In States with large numbers of plants, survey procedures are designed to obtain monthly reports from all large plants and from a sample of small plants. Monthly estimates are based upon returns from about 70 percent of the plants which account for 70 to 90 percent of the total production of major dairy products.

Revision Policy: Monthly estimates are subject to revision the month following the preliminary estimates. Annual estimates are published in the "**Dairy Products**" report published each April which includes any revisions made to current and previous year. In preparing the annual report, an attempt is made to get information from all plants.

The next "Dairy Products" report will be released at 3 p.m. ET on April 3, 2001.

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
