Dairy Products Prices Highlights

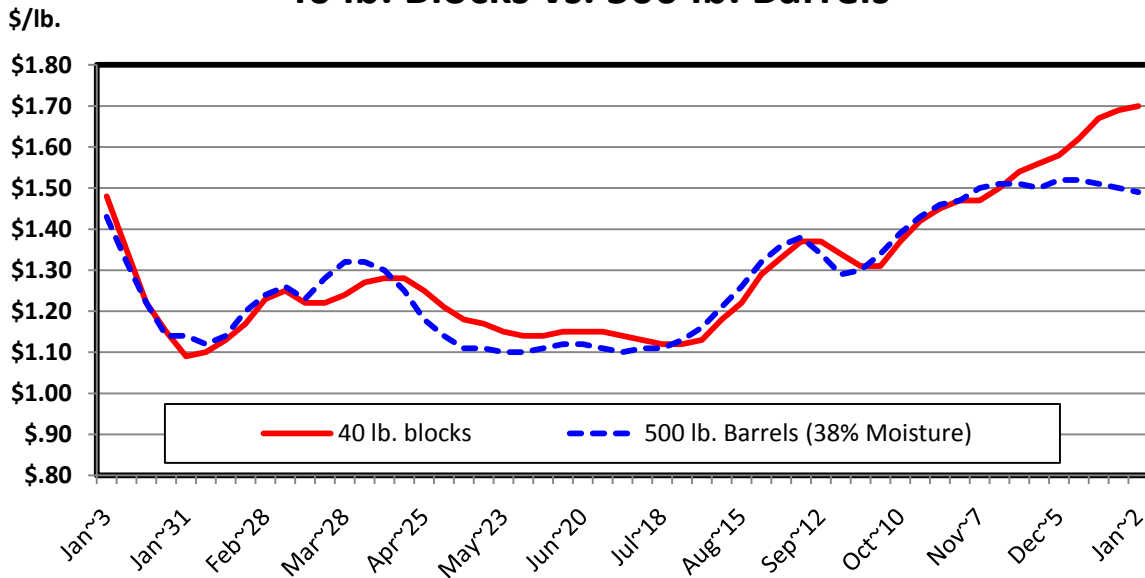
Cheddar Cheese prices received for US 40 pound Blocks averaged \$1.70 per pound for the week ending January 2. The price per pound increased 0.9 cents from the previous week. The price for US 500 pound Barrels adjusted to 38 percent moisture averaged \$1.49 per pound, down 1.2 cents from the previous week.

Butter prices received for 25 kilogram and 68 pound boxes meeting USDA Grade AA standards averaged \$1.34 per pound for the week ending January 2. The U.S. price per pound decreased 1.9 cents from the previous week.

Nonfat Dry Milk prices received for bag, tote and tanker sales meeting USDA Extra Grade or USPH Grade A standards averaged \$1.28 per pound for the week ending January 2. The U.S. price per pound decreased 5.2 cents from the previous week.

Dry Whey prices received for bag, tote and tanker sales meeting USDA Extra Grade standards averaged 38.6 cents per pound for the week ending January 2. The U.S. price per pound increased 1.3 cents from the previous week.

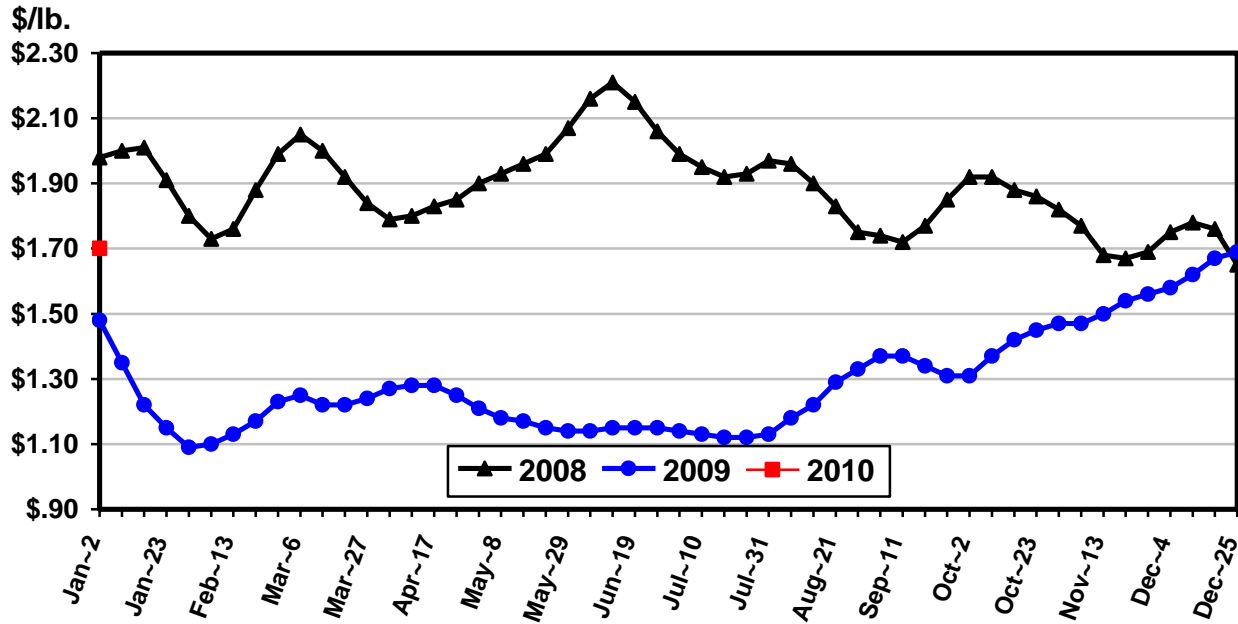

Cheddar Cheese Prices, U.S. 40 lb. Blocks



Procedures and Reliability: The Weekly Dairy Product Prices program consists of 20 plants reporting 40 pound cheddar blocks, 16 plants reporting 500 pound cheddar barrels, 23 plants reporting butter, 38 plants reporting nonfat dry milk, and 23 plants reporting dry whey. There are 7 plants in the Minnesota/Wisconsin Region reporting 40 pound cheddar blocks and 10 plants in the Minnesota/Wisconsin Region reporting 500 pound cheddar barrels. Plants counts are by commodity, plants reporting multiple commodities are represented in each commodity. Price information included in this report is provided each week by manufacturers of these products. Data are collected by fax and electronic mail each week for the previous week. The Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS) conducts on-site plant reviews. Price information collected is for the (wholesale) initial point of sale for:

- **Cheddar cheese in 40 pound blocks**, colored between 6 and 8 on the National Cheese Institute color chart, meeting Wisconsin State Brand, USDA Grade A, or better standards.
- **Cheddar cheese in 500 pound barrels**, white, meeting Wisconsin State Brand, USDA Grade A, or better standards.
- **Salted butter (80% butterfat)**, fresh or storage, in 25 kilogram and 68 pound boxes meeting USDA Grade AA standards.
- **Non-fortified, nonfat dry milk** in 25 kilogram bags, 50 pound bags, totes, and tankers meeting USDA Extra Grade or USPH Grade A standards.
- **Edible non-hygroscopic dry whey** in 25 kilogram bags, 50 pound bags, totes, and tankers meeting USDA Extra Grade standards.

A transaction is complete when the product is “shipped out” and “title transfers.” Re-sales of purchased product, forward pricing and intra-company sales are excluded.
