Condensed and evaporated milk prices for January are based on reports made by manufacturers throughout the United States regardless of the degree of concentration or solid content of the goods sold by different concerns, - it being assumed that the large majority must comply with Federal Standards for interstate shipment. Exceptions bear relatively little weight in the averages obtained.

Final analysis of the above two tables shows on February 1, unfilled orders in excess of available stocks of 15,840,930 pounds condensed case goods and 98,267 pounds condensed bulk goods, and available stocks in excess of unfilled orders of 44,585,923 pounds evaporated case goods and 434,758 pounds evaporated bulk goods. For all commodities reported unsold stocks exceeded unfilled orders by 29,081,484 pounds.
