Farm Work Force Continues to Decline

The Nation's farm labor force totaled 6,240,000 for the week of September 18-24. This represented a slight increase from a month earlier but was 6 percent below the corresponding period in September 1965. The family work force, which consisted of 4,395,000 workers, was 3 percent above the comparable period in August 1966, but 6 percent below a year earlier.

The number of hired farm workers, at 1,845,000 persons, was down 7 percent from 1965 and off 5 percent from a month earlier. The decline from August 1966 was greater than usual as harvest of some major crops in the South and Southeast was delayed by showers and cool temperatures. Another factor was the continued increase in the use of mechanical harvesters, especially for cotton.

Farm workers on reporting farms averaged 38.7 hours of farm work during the September survey week. This nearly matched the average of 38.6 hours a month earlier. Farm operators averaged 45.7 hours and other family members averaged 32.2 hours of farm work. Hired farm workers did 33.9 hours of work compared with 32.9 hours during the comparable week in August 1966.

Farm Wage Rates Continue Upward Trend

The level of farm wage rates reported by farm operators on October 1, 1966, was 9 percent higher than a year earlier, and 40 percent above the 1957-59 average. The average cash rate per hour, without board or room, increased 8 percent over October 1, 1965, to \$1.18 per hour. Monthly, weekly, and daily rates also showed similar gains. The October 1 State averages for 1966, on page 8, show the generally consistent trend in wage rate increases by States and regions for the different hiring arrangements. In index terms, the national average reached 812 (1910-14=100), up from the 1965 average of 746.

Wage rates reported for farm workers in Alaska were as follows: per month with house, \$400; per month with board and room, \$300; per day without board and room, \$16.00; and per hour without board or room, \$2.10.

Corn harvest during the survey week was getting underway throughout the Corn Belt. The Ohio crop was 55 percent mature with less than 5 percent harvested. Illinois harvest was limited by high moisture. Harvest of the Iowa crop began with about 76 percent of the crop mature. Maturity and harvest of Missouri corn was slowed by rains; harvest had reached 9 percent completion.

Harvest was underway but behind normal in the South; showers and cool temperatures slowed the pace in many areas. Texas harvest was 80 percent complete and Oklahoma 50 percent.

Soybean harvest was 4 percent complete in Missouri, 10 percent in Indiana, and 11 percent in Iowa. Illinois harvest, delayed by rainy weather, was one-fifth complete compared with the 5-year average of one-third by this date. Arkansas soybean development made good progress, although scattered areas would have benefitted from added moisture. Recent rains improved late-crop soybeans in areas of the Southeast.

Cotton maturity and harvest were slowed by showers and cool temperatures over most of the southeastern States. Picking was generally 2 to 3 weeks behind average. Texas harvest was 21 percent complete compared with 32 percent a year ago. Picking was nearly finished in the Coastal Bend and Rio Grande Valley and defoliation was active in the Blacklands. About 7 percent of the Mississippi crop had been picked. California and Arizona cotton was opening rapidly. Harvest progressed in Arizona but was still limited.

Tobacco harvest was active during the week as harvest of Burley reached 85 percent complete in Tennessee, 55 percent in Virginia, and 45 percent in Kentucky. One-third of the West Virginia and 80 percent of the North Carolina crops were harvested. Virginia flue-cured harvest was 65 percent complete.

Apple pickers were on the job during the week as picking of New York McIntosh intensified. Jonathan and Red Delicious apples were being harvested in Virginia. Picking of late apples was active in south Pennsylvania and the Michigan harvest continued in volume. Picking was well along in Washington with quality good; cooler temperatures were needed for coloring. Harvest activity for California fruits, nuts, and vegetables was making normal progress. Potato digging progressed rapidly in Maine but was slowed by rains on Long Island and in upstate New York.
