Farm Labor Activities Focus on Fall Harvest

Nationally, the farm labor force for the week of September 21-27 was virtually unchanged from the August survey week but was 3 percent below the September 1968 survey week. The estimated 5,424,000 total workers include 3,905,000 farm operators and other unpaid family members. The 1,519,000 hired workers represent a 9 percent decline from August.

Farm Workers averaged 39.0 hours during the September survey week--up fractionally from September last year. Farm operators averaged 44.4 hours and other unpaid family members worked 31.9 hours. Hired workers averaged 35.7 hours, 7 percent above the August survey week.

Corn Crop Nearing Maturity

The 1969 Corn Crop was nearing maturity in the Corn Belt States under favorable weather conditions. Harvest was underway in the Southern part of the Corn Belt. Harvest in some South Atlantic and South Central States was curtailed by wet soils.

Winter wheat seeding was advancing in major growing areas although rain delayed seeding in parts of Texas and Oklahoma. Nearly 50 percent of the Kansas acreage had been planted. Lack of adequate soil moisture had slowed seeding in the Northern Plains States.

Cotton harvest and defoliation was slowed by rain in most of the Southern States. Boll rot increased in the areas of excessive moisture. Harvest was 24 percent complete in Texas, 28 percent in Georgia, and 15 percent in Mississippi and Louisiana. In California, picking was started in the San Joaquin Valley, and in the desert areas of California and Arizona it was in full swing.

Soybean harvest was underway in the central and eastern Corn Belt States and in some South Central States. Maturity lagged behind normal in many States including the Corn Belt. Illinois had combined about 20 percent of the acreage while Missouri and Kansas had combined only 8 and 4 percent, respectively.

Tobacco harvest neared completion in North Carolina and Virginia. Harvest was about 90 percent complete in Kentucky and Tennessee with tobacco stripping getting started. Peanuts were 96 percent dug in Georgia but only 22 percent in Texas. Rice, dry bean, and sugar beet harvests were at varying stages in their respective growing areas.

Apple picking was active in most major growing States. Harvest of grapes for crushing was at peak levels in California. Picking of late season peaches neared completion. California almond harvest was past peak while walnut harvest was increasing.

Potato digging was in full swing in Maine, Idaho, and many other Fall crop States. Harvest of the late season vegetable crops was active in many Northern States with some crops nearing completion. Planting of winter vegetables continued in Florida, California, Texas, and Arizona.

Farm Wage Rates Maintain Upward Pace

The farm wage rates reported for hired workers on October 1 were 7 percent above a year earlier. The average cash rate per hour without board or room was \$1.51, up from \$1.41 in October a year ago. This does not include earnings of piece rate workers. Similar increases were registered in pay rates by the day, week, and month.

Alaska's Farm Wage Rates

Wage rates reported for farm workers in Alaska were as follows: per month with house, \$430.; per month, with board and room, \$330.; per day, without board or room, \$18.00; and per hour, without board or room, \$2.40.
