## Farm Workers' Wages Higher

The Nation's farm labor force totaled 3,361,200 workers during the week of December 24-30, 1972. This is 16 percent fewer than in the corresponding week in November and one percent below December 1971. There were 2,700,900 working farm operators and unpaid family workers and 660,300 hired farm laborers working in the December week. The 1972 annual average of 4,392,000 workers is down about one percent from 1971.

Farm workers averaged 33.1 hours during the December survey week which included Christmas Day. This compares with a 35.0 hour week in November and 32.5 hours in December 1971. Farm operators worked an average of 33.4 hours per week, unpaid family members 29.2 hours and hired workers 35.3 hours per week.

## Wage Rates Increase

Wages of farm workers on January 1, 1973 were up about 9 percent from January 1, 1972. The hourly rate without board and room increased 16 cents to \$1.98 per hour. Pay rates by the day, week and month were up similarly. Farm wages during calendar year 1972 averaged about 7 percent more than in 1971.

## Harvest Behind Normal

The Nation's late corn harvest made only limited progress during the week of December 24-30. Usually, almost all of the crop is harvested by early December. Mild temperatures continued over the North Central States, but wet, sticky field conditions delayed harvest. In the South the corn picking was about complete.

Cotton harvest in Texas made good progress during the survey week. Harvest in the South Atlantic States was nearing completion. However, picking was delayed in Mississippi and Louisiana by wet weather. Cotton harvest in Arizona and Nevada was winding up.

Harvesting of soybeans in the United States was about 5 weeks behind normal. Usually the soybean crop is completely harvested by mid-November in the North and by mid-December in the South. Muddy conditions in many Corn Belt States limited harvest to early morning and late evening hours when the ground was frozen.

Citrus supplies continued to increase in Texas but some areas have fruit sizing problems. The navel orange harvest continued slow in San Joaquin Valley of California as shippers were waiting for the appearance of frost damage from other areas. Pecan harvest was nearing completion in Georgia, Mississippi, and Texas.

Cold weather slowed growth and maturity of vegetable crops in Florida last week; damage was limited mostly to tender leaf burn of young plants. The carrot and cabbage harvest was in full swing at San Antonio, Texas and continued in the Winter Garden area. In California, cold weather slowed broccoli and cauliflower harvesting at Salinas and lettuce movement at Imperial.

Farm employment represents number of family and hired labor working during the survey week. Family labor includes farm operators working on farms one hour or more plus other family members working 15 hours or more without receiving cash wages during survey week. Hired workers include all persons working one hour or more for cash wages during the survey week. These data should not be confused with the data published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) derived from the Current Population Survey (CPS). The BLS data are derived from a household survey where each member 16 years of age and older is classified as performing farm or nonfarm work on the basis of major activity during the survey week.
