FARM WAGE RATES FOR FIELD AND LIVESTOCK WORKERS

This release has combined field and livestock worker wage rates by States, for 1974-1982. State quarterly and annual average wage rates are published for 1974 through 1980 and a January through April combined average for 1980 and 1981 has been computed. For 1982 only, a July combined field and livestock wage rate is available.

The reported average wage rates for field workers and livestock workers were weighted together by the number of hours worked by each class of worker to derive the combined field and livestock worker wage rate.

The Quarterly Farm Labor Surveys were discontinued after April 1981. An annual survey was implemented in 1982 which surveys establishments in July obtaining data for the week that includes the 12th.
